#### **PASTOR'S REFLECTION**



#### A Family Conversation

I hope this new year will be full of blessings for you, for our parish and for our world. We all need them and, fortunately, God is there to give them!

You may have figured this out by now: I am not one who talks constantly about money. You could say that I heard that enough from pulpits when I was young and decided way back then that

constantly talking about money got in the way of talking about the goodness of God. I don't think I was wrong, either.

Of course, the assumption on which my thinking hinged was that the Catholic people. being mature and understanding the importance of their parish, gave – and would do so generously - not because they were constantly cajoled but because they gave from the heart. And I don't think that's wrong, either.

Last year at this time, we began the new, annual practice of enquiring, our brothers and sisters, at what level you intended to support Saint Kateri Parish financially in fiscal year 2016. Some thought we were asking you to raise the amount from former years but it was simply a request that you do some planning of how much the Lord inspires you to give – that way I could make responsible use of the funds available by planning a balanced budget. So many of you cooperated in this and, with the immense help of Carol Wilke, our Director of Finance and Administration, and of the Finance Council, we drew up a realistic, balanced budget for the fiscal year that ends next June.

Andrew Williams, co-chair of the Finance Council, has noticed what I – and perhaps you – have noticed since July: we have not often been making our budgeted amounts in collections. He recently wrote me,

"Since 10/1/15 (thirteen weeks) there have only been two weeks where this year's offertory was more than last year. This unhealthy trend is masked by reduced operating costs: principally in building maintenance. Obviously, it's good that costs are down, but building maintenance is most unpredictable and can skyrocket suddenly."

Did you know that in 2016, Christmas falls on a Sunday? This is interesting, and for some, a relief, but as your pastor, I worry that it may mean one less collection (and the Christmas collection this year was \$38,000). That's a big chunk of change: someone's yearly salary... See what I have to worry about?

We'll be asking all of you once again to take the time to pray about the financial contribution your family wishes to make to the mission of the Church in Irondequoit, and beyond, through Saint Kateri Parish. The Basilian Fathers, my "family" certainly will happily return our pledge quickly. I hope your family will as well.

Would you and your family please do these two things?

- 1. Prayerfully decide and let us know at what level you will support Saint Kateri in the next fiscal year, and
- 2. Follow through, even when you are out of town a weekend here or there, by making each regular contribution.
