**Training for NEW Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**

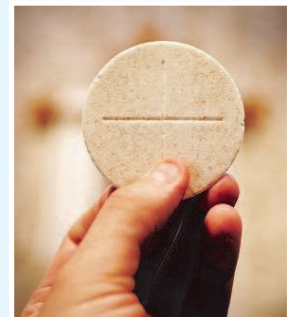

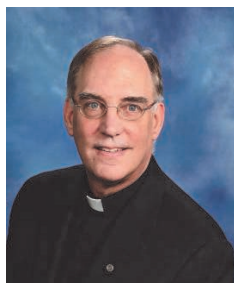

**PASTOR’S REFLECTION**



**90 Is Good!**

When I was on a bowling team in grad school I won a team award: “Most Encouraging.” I didn’t even realize I was doing it most times but when people didn’t get a strike or missed a spare, I had encouraging words to help them hang in there and keep trying. I remember once somebody laughed out loud when I said, “Eight is good!”

In the first week of the new year, we received word that, thanks to 1,100 contributors and the amazing generosity of a parishioner who once again matched the donations of 215 **NEW** donors, Saint Kateri Parish has reached 92% of our goal for the Catholic Ministries Appeal. That’s really good (and the appeal doesn’t really end until May)! We’ve been through some sparse years as far as this appeal goes, and we’ve found it necessary, at budgeting time, to anticipate paying the shortfall to the tune of about \$30,000 to 50,000. Think “someone’s salary.” This year, already at 92%, we are only \$25,000 short. If it stays at this number, we will not have reached our goal, but we also will not have to spend as much as we had feared on shortfall. So 90 is good!

More important than all the numbers and dollars, though, the participation of all of us together in this effort speaks to me of something much more basic and beautiful: our love and commitment to our Catholic faith and our Universal Church. I know you share with me an admiration for the work of people who minister to the poorest among us, both in cities and in the rural areas. I’d love to do that type of ministry myself, but God has called me to be your pastor and I’m grateful that I can ensure, through the contribution of my local Basilian community, that good work like that can be done with our help. People come to know Jesus Christ through the amazing array of ministries and services that the Catholic Church provides in our ten-county diocese. Those who have participated in CMA can say a prayer of gratitude that we are a part of the life-enhancing ministry in every corner, street and church in this moderate-sized piece of the Universal Church.

Frankly, as the pastor of the largest and newest parish in the diocese, I can’t begin to tell you how valuable the services of the dedicated staff of our diocese are to me and to the parish staffs across this wide diocese – and ultimately to you and your family and neighbors. If a parish like ours had to hire support people for our many complicated machines, means of communication, aid in personnel, accounting, liturgical assistance, musical expertise – the list goes on and on – we could never afford it. Quick and expert support is only a phone call away. It amazes me!

It’s time to celebrate 90! It’s really good. And if we end up reaching our goal by May, there will be even more to celebrate in this, our 5<sup>th</sup> year of existence as a parish! The goal of us as Catholics reaching out to bring Christ to the world continues to be met, thanks to so many of you!
