PASTOR'S REFLECTION



The Relegation of Saint Salome Church

On January 12 after the meeting of the Diocese of Rochester's Presbyteral Council, Bishop Matano decreed that Saint Salome Church is "relegated from sacred to profane but not sordid use." In Church language, "Sacred" use of a church building is use for worship, ministry and instruction of the faithful. "Profane" use

would be for good and wholesome activities that are not worship, ministry and Christian instruction. "Sordid" use would be any use of the former church building that offends the dignity of a former sacred site. Basically, this decree gives Saint Kateri Parish permission to rent or sell the property, should the opportunity present itself. This decree was announced in all masses the weekend of January 16 and 17 at our parish and a copy of the decree is available at the parish offices.

As you may know, the Irondequoit Pastoral Planning Group (IPPG), consisting of representatives of Saint Margaret Mary, Saint Thomas the Apostle, Saint Cecilia, Christ the King and Saint Salome parishes and the Saint Ann Community met over a ten-year period to discuss and plan for the future of the Roman Catholic Church in the town. The group worked diligently, spending long hours in prayer, study, analysis and discussion seeking the best direction for the Catholics of Irondequoit. In 2012, Bishop Matthew Clark decreed that through "extinctive union" the five parishes would become one, and Kateri Tekakwitha would be its Patron. With the creation of Blessed Kateri Parish (later Saint Kateri), the five parishes ceased to exist as individual parishes. They united under the new name, with one pastor using three worship sites for daily and weekend worship, Saint Cecilia, Saint Margaret Mary and Christ the King. Included in the IPPG's final report was the recommendation that the new parish seek relegation of the churches not included in regular worship.

While we knew this change was coming, that doesn't make it any less poignant for our brothers and sisters whose lives of faith grew and flowered as they worshipped at Saint Salome. I can only imagine that this news brings feelings of pain and sadness. As a Catholic family, we care for each other, and we mark all of life's passages with rituals and community gatherings — even celebrations. I will be getting together with a group of parishioners and some staff members in order to develop a fitting manner to honor the people and the transition we are undertaking together. After we've met, I'll let you know about the plans and invite you to partake in this important moment of our parish's life, too. Your ideas are most welcome.

This Decree has no bearing on the pastoral ministry provided Catholics participating in the Saint Kateri Tekakwitha – Latin Mass Community who, at the request of Bishop Matano and by a friendly memorandum of understanding, are renting the Saint Thomas the Apostle church building and former parish center for sacred use.

As always let us pray with and for one another as we move as a family in the direction our God is leading us.

DECREE

Saint Salome Church at 4282 Culver Road in Irondequoit, New York, is hereby relegated from sacred to profane, but not sordid use as provided for in canon 1222, §2 of the *Code of Canon Law*.

On January 12, 2016, the Presbyteral Council of the Diocese of Rochester was heard concerning this action as required by the same canon 1222, §2. The opinion of the Presbyteral Council was that the church be relegated from sacred to profane but not sordid use.

The Reverend Paul F. English, CSB, the Pastor of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish, submitted his petition after extensive consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Finance Council. At the time the parish was erected, parishioners were invited to express their personal opinion in this matter.

The petition of the Pastor was motivated by the assessment of outstanding capital needs required to preserve the building for use, the lack of available funds, and the very limited use of the church building since the creation of the Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish through the extinctive union of Saint Cecilia Parish, Saint Margaret Mary Parish, Christ the King Parish, Saint Thomas the Apostle Parish, and Saint Salome Parish, all in Irondequoit, New York.

The provisions of this decree must be announced publicly at each Mass celebrated in the parish of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha on the Sunday following receipt. A copy of the decree must be posted in the parish office.

Any person aggrieved by this decree must seek recourse in accord with canons 1732-1739 of the *Code of Canon Law*. That process requires that the person seeking recourse must first request, in writing, that I revoke or emend this decree. The request for revocation or emendation must be made within the peremptory period of ten useful days from the legitimate notification of this decree.

The effective date of this decree is the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 24, 2016.



Anointing of the Sick - Please call the parish office or see a priest after Mass.




