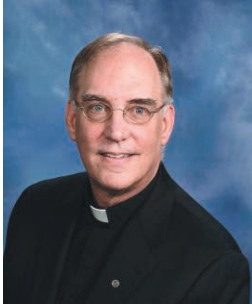

Special Days This Lent

I saw a very interesting invitation this week. It began with “Don’t give up chocolate this Lent!” Just so you know, I never give up chocolate! But the invitation was intriguing so I continued to read. It was about an “each day of Lent” reflection series, presented by a Catholic man named Matthew Kelly, inviting us to have the “best Lent ever!”

Kelly bids us to spend a short time each day, with the help of a brief reflection, with Jesus Christ. It struck me when I read the invitation that this might well be a wonderful thing for us all to do these next 40 days. We’d all be meditating on the same reflection, we’d all have a time of shared prayer and even have something to chat about when we meet in church or at Wegman’s or at the gym! I’m planning on doing this. Consider joining me! It’s online at DynamicCatholic.com/Lent.

In this very special Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis has called upon all Christians to look at the instruction Jesus left for us to put into practice the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. You may think at first that you wouldn’t be able to name them (test yourself before you look here), but you may surprise yourself! You see, they are what Christians are known for when we’re at our best – and I’m sure you’ve practiced a lot of them without knowing that they were part of a list.

Jesus himself gives us the corporal works of mercy when he says, “I was hungry and you fed me, thirsty and you gave me to drink, naked and you clothed me, a stranger and you welcomed me, sick and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.” Two things about these: These are really kind and loving things to do, and we generally feel good about doing them. When we treat others this way, we’re at our best, and they benefit. Some call this a “win-win.” But what we often don’t realize is that in doing these things to anyone who is hurting or in need, we are actually showing kindness to Jesus Christ himself, returning the kindness and loving care with which he loves us and cares for us at all moments of every day. This is practicing mercy, mutually.

As a Saint Kateri family, we say that within our mission is the vocation to be Christ to the world. In the coming 40 days, let’s take each day as a special one, a day of salvation, a day of encounter with Jesus. We can be the healing, caring, consoling Christ to others. But we can also, if such be our circumstances, be the hungry Christ or thirsty or sick or in awful situations, and Christ himself will, through our brothers and sisters, come to bring his mercy to us.

It is my hope that at the conclusion of these special days, each one of us will love Christ, who first loved us, more deeply and share his love joyfully through our Saint Kateri family.
