

PASTOR'S REFLECTION



God Is With You Now. Walk With Jesus!

We're a couple of weeks into our great journey, our Lenten "pilgrimage," filled with so many important, little details along the side of every road, at every turn.

Have you thought about how a "journey" is different from a "trip?" On a trip, we're interested in arriving at our destination.

We go through the necessary – often inconvenient – details of what route to take, what means of transportation, what to pack, etc. But these details are minuscule in comparison to the importance of the destination.

I think of a niece who went to Disney World in Florida a year or so ago. As the departure date drew ever nearer, her voice seemed to get higher! She had every toy and had seen all the movies; now she was going to be there! If you asked her about details of how she got there, whom she sat next to, what she ate, what interesting people were on the plane, she wouldn't have a clue! She just couldn't get there fast enough. That's a trip!

Pilgrims on a journey also have a destination in mind. It's what propels them to take to the open road, often walking or riding a bike or a horse. In ancient times, pilgrims walked clear across Europe or Asia Minor to arrive at the Holy Land. Modern Catholic pilgrims, too, make the journey to Rome or to other holy sites. In May, a group of us will make a bicycle pilgrimage, journeying to Fonda, NY, Saint Kateri's home. We could much more easily go there by bus or car, but we'll journey by bike over four or five days. And as we slowly ride past the miles of canal path and road, we will be with other pilgrims from our group. We'll notice the sights, the people, the sounds, the pains, the full human experience of journeying, and we'll pray. Details become important – a vital part of the journey itself!

On our journey this Lent, let's try to be aware of daily details, and see God's hand in them, or God's hand helping us with them! Jesus walks with us every step of the way. This I do not doubt! Earlier this month, our Reconciliation and Renewal retreat had record numbers: 60 participants had profound experiences with the person of Jesus. Parishioners recognize Jesus in the needy and poor brothers and sisters around us and have decided to touch them – so, Saint Kateri Parish is pursuing a relationship with a homeless shelter and already seeks to meet the hungry Jesus by collecting and providing food. Many parishioners have signed up online for fascinating daily spiritual video reflections at DynamicCatholic.com. Jesus is walking with us now in the ordinary, daily stuff!

Where are we headed? To a time when we all as "friends and neighbors joyfully share and live the Gospel and the transforming love of Jesus Christ through our Parish Family." It's a day-by-day thing, appreciating the details – and the persons – the Lord puts on our path.




