



MESSAGE FROM DIRECTOR OF FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION



"God is an experience of supreme love." ~ Elizabeth Gilbert, Eat, Pray, Love

I have the distinct privilege of serving you – the parishioners of Saint Kateri Parish – by attending to everyday finance and administrative duties, enabling our priests and ministries to focus on fulfilling our vision. I am feeling challenged with the task of writing this week's reflection – praying for insight on how to communicate as beautifully as our devoted Pastor.

At the Town Hall Meeting and in the bulletin a few weeks ago, we discussed finances for the first six months of the current 2015-16 Fiscal Year. First, we want to acknowledge and thank you for your generous contributions totaling approximately \$800,000 from regular collections. Annualizing that amount for the full year, equates to \$1,600,000, consistent with the level of giving from previous years. Beyond the money, so many of our parishioners volunteer in various ministries and programs - lovingly sharing their time and talents – receiving fulfillment and blessings.

As we embark on the annual budget process for the 2016-17 Fiscal Year, we are once again going to conduct an in-house "Commitment to Giving" Campaign. We are mailing a commitment card to about 2,000 registered families in early March. We ask you to review your current level of giving and respond with your future level, based on your unique set of circumstances. Please help us take the guesswork out of the budget process – return your card by April 3rd. The closer we get to a 100% rate of return, the higher likelihood we have of building a balanced budget – with planned expenses equal to expected revenue.

We encourage you to take as much time as necessary to determine your right level of giving. Then take five minutes more to automate the process of making your contribution. There are two secure methods of automation: 1) Sign up for Online Giving at www.KateriIrondequoit.org (by using your computer at home); or 2) Create an automatic payment from your personal checking account (by visiting your bank online or in person). Currently, approximately 10% of our parishioners are taking advantage of automation. Let's increase to 25% this year, 50% next year, and 100% the following year. With you taking this very logical first step, we are able to automate the whole process – from collecting envelopes at Mass, to counting and recording contributions, and finally to making bank deposits.

In response to your feedback from last year's commitment campaign, we created a new section on the card to capture additional one-time donations. We graciously accept your contributions and promise to honor your designated choices. Our top priorities include building and grounds capital projects, Saint Kateri School scholarships, and all parish ministries. Beyond any financial commitment, we all benefit when you attend our services, participate in our events, and donate precious time and energy on various committees.

Please join us all year as we celebrate a significant milestone together - Saint Kateri Parish Five Year Anniversary! Save the weekend of May 13 through May 15 – look for announcements regarding specific activities - invite your families, friends, and neighbors!!
