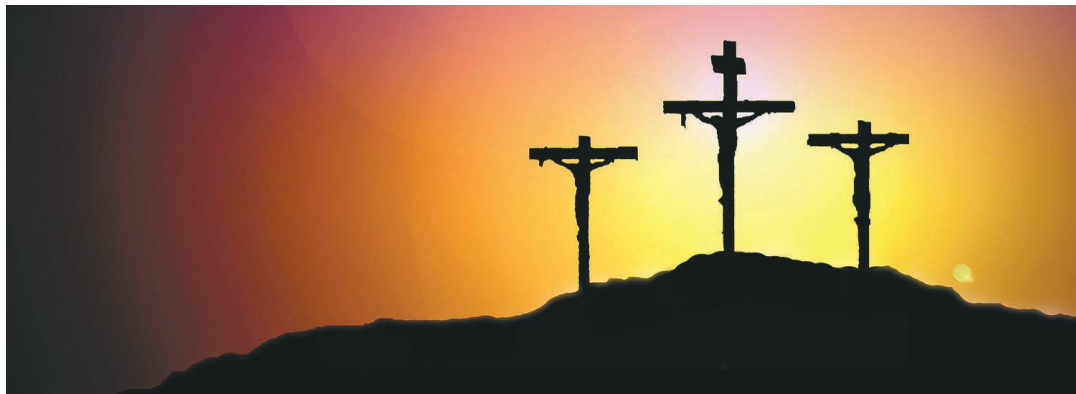

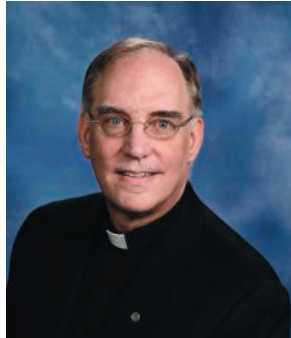

PASTOR'S REFLECTION



We Have Seen And We Have Heard

One of my new favorite hymns is one we have sung several times this season:

*"In these days of Lenten journey, we have seen
and we have heard..."*

We're now entering the fifth week on this journey. Next weekend, the Church around the world begins the solemn commemoration of Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem to hymns and palm branches hailing the arrival of the Messiah. We are aware of what happens only a few days later...

Our own hearts beat almost imperceptibly faster, knowing that we, along with Jesus, are nearing those holiest of days. It's a time to recall how our Lenten journey started off. It's likely that we didn't perfectly live up to the plans we made to walk in step with Jesus at all times, but you and I have made an effort to realize that these 40 days hold something special, something mysterious, something holy.

Last Wednesday, across not only our Diocese but across the world, many Catholics turned to the Lord for mercy and sacramental reconciliation. Pope Francis said it so well,

*"When faced with the gravity of sin, God responds with the fullness of mercy.
Mercy will always be greater than any sin, and no one can place limits on
the love of God who is ever ready to forgive."*

The Pope invites us, in this Jubilee Year of Mercy, to "allow God to surprise us. He never tires of casting open the doors of his heart and of repeating that he loves us and wants to share his love with us."

In these last two weeks, as we near the days in which we will recall in a sacred way just how God showed his forgiving and restoring love, let our hearts and our minds turn in prayer to Christ Jesus. I invite us all to make these next two weeks a special sort of retreat. Let us "carve out," ten or fifteen minutes, whatever time of the day or night that works for each of us. Let it be a time for silence in which we meditate on the sacrifice of Jesus for each of us. Perhaps we will feel sadness for his deep sufferings. Perhaps gratitude for his accepting undeserved punishment to save us. Perhaps we will grow in our love for the one who has loved us from the beginning, who never ceases to love us and who places into our hearts the confidence of children beloved of their Father.

What message have you seen and heard from our loving God in these past five weeks? How has his Word brought new thoughts to mind or deepened your love and faith in Him? What were special gifts to your soul this Lent through nature? Through relationships? Even through struggles? We have never been abandoned, even though it might feel that way. Let us take the silent time each day for the concluding days of Lent to recall what we have seen and heard – and discover just how close our God has remained to you and to me.

Blessings for our journey!

A Message of Gratitude from our Parish Christmas Basket Program

Although there could never be enough words to describe my gratitude, I want you all to know how special you made my Christmas this year. I never expected to receive gifts with my Christmas food basket. I thought at first the bag was additional food items, so you could only imagine my surprise when I opened a bag full of wrapped gifts. I was so elated that day that I would have something to open on Christmas morning, I even set up a small tree and arranged them all underneath. Every day I look at them and smiled. On Christmas morning, I opened them one by one and literally cried from how deeply my heart was touched.

*I'm disabled with a severe anxiety disorder. I live alone and battle every day with panic attacks, many days I'm unable to even leave my house. The reason I cried when I opened each gift was not just from the gratitude of having something to open, but **because I felt like St. Nick himself must have personally chosen each one just for me.***

There were shower gels and lotion from Bath & Body Works which I love and could never afford to splurge on for myself. There were warm fuzzy socks and candles, hand cream and a beautiful scarf I wear now on days I do get out. There were gift cards, among them one to Panera Bread which I used to treat my mom to a lunch which I would never have been able to afford to do for her. The last gift I opened came with a hand written card made out to me. It was a beautiful Winter Magic coloring book and pencils. I use it every day to help ease my anxiety.

So I don't know how, or who, or how many good hearts came together to give me such a special Christmas. I wish I could personally thank and hug each one of you. I know this is only a small gesture but it comes with the utmost sincerity.

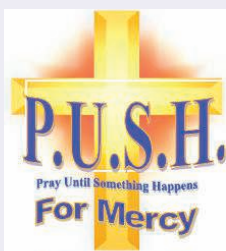

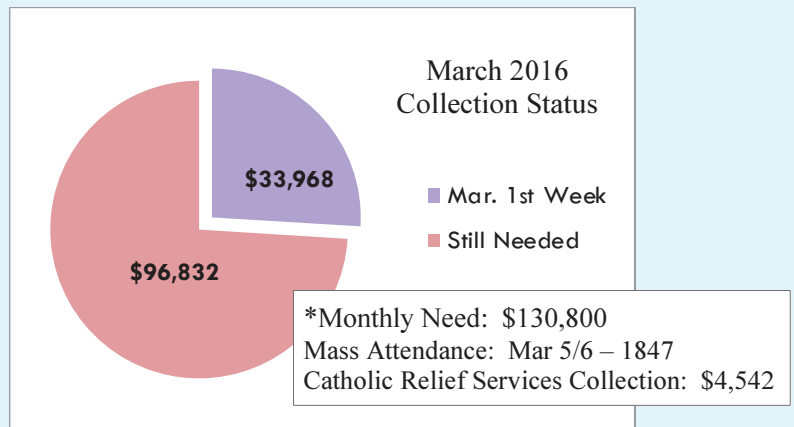

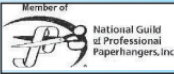
