#### **PASTOR'S REFLECTION**



#### Living God's Mercy

This is the weekend of Divine Mercy. As you know, our Holy Father Pope Francis has asked us all to both meditate on it and put mercy into practice in this "Jubilee Year." Doesn't this seem to presume that we are all well-versed about mercy? In my conversations with others, I don't think this is necessarily so. Let's look, if only briefly, at Divine Mercy.

You've heard of the Works of Mercy, both Corporal and Spiritual: ways we reach out and actively help others. Doing them is a special blessing, and it's hard to imagine a world without them. I'll return to them another week. Meanwhile, let's consider the wisdom of the old Latin saying, "nemo dat quod non habet." "You can't give what you don't have." Before we can be bringers of mercy, we have to be receivers and possessors of it! One week after Easter we're still standing in awe of God's unparalleled mercy in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross, and his victory shown forth in his Resurrection. Christ, who loves us to the end, took upon himself the sins of the world: your sins, mine, those of all! He suffered in our place so that we might have a clear path to the fullness of life. Sacrificed for you, for me! It's personal! In quiet moments, when we get the chance just to sit back and take this all in, we are liable to feel a deep sense of gratitude to Christ for undergoing this for us, for second and third chances, for aiding us when we were helpless and didn't deserve it, not out of duty or some sense of responsibility, but out of pure concern for us, *out of love*!

Pope Francis has asked that special, holy places be set up for us all to go and thank God for this mercy. In fact, he has asked that a Holy Door be designated in every diocese around the world, making a mini-pilgrimage feasible for all Catholics. The same grace that is associated with the Holy Door in Rome will be associated with the local Holy Doors. In preparation for going, he invites us to do five things: experience the Sacrament of Reconciliation, receive holy Communion, pray for the Pope, reject all attachment to sin, and pass through a Holy Door.

Aren't we fortunate in Irondequoit to be the next parish over from the Cathedral, where our diocesan Holy Door is? Our parish hopes to organize various groups of pilgrims throughout the year, by age group or common professions, study groups, clubs, confraternities, Knights or just ordinary people, for pilgrimage to the Holy Door. Some may even walk all the way. I hope to join them, as I'm planning to join the pilgrims on bicycles going to the Shrine of Saint Kateri in Fonda, NY, at the end of May.

Please make sure to take time regularly to consider prayerfully the abundant mercy God has given you. And consider being a pilgrim in some way, with your family if you can, prayerfully joining other Catholics in this powerful expression of faith.


#### **Easter Prayer**




who attended and those who helped make this a faith-filled event.




