PASTOR'S REFLECTION



Do You Love Me?

The question Jesus asks Simon Peter in this weekend's Gospel can bring a number of different responses, depending on whether someone is asking you or asking somebody else. On the lake shore two thousand years ago, Jesus was asking someone else if he, Peter, loved him. Interesting situation. We know the background all too well. Peter, who bravely promised never to turn his back on him, actually denied three times that he even

knew Jesus when things went so badly. Peter got to know a different side of himself than he had ever known existed – the side that can be so wrong; it pains him. We can only imagine the guilt he must feel as he and his boat mates return to the north to leave things behind and be fishermen again. He must have hated the coward he was, both because he abandoned the Lord he loved and because his ideal of himself was now shattered on the dusty ground.

So Jesus, resurrected and very much alive, questions Simon Peter, "Do you love me more than these?" and we, like spectators at a show we've seen many times before but find deeply satisfying each time we see it, witness Peter's reply, with such relief and gratitude saying yes, "you know I love you." A simple exchange but filled with such emotion and healing. And it repeats twice more, each time with Jesus commissioning Peter to make a difference in the lives of others.

So that's somebody out there asking another somebody out there, "Do you love me?" Interesting, though safe for us who are observing. Have you ever heard a young couple talking when one of them asks this question of the other? It might indicate that there's some doubt there, that the relationship is getting rocky or maybe that one definitely loves the other but is unsure if it is reciprocated! In any event, it becomes very personal and very delicate, doesn't it?

Now, however, in this season of the Resurrection, Jesus turns from that safe page somehow, looks you, looks me in the eye and asks, "Do you love me?" If we give it some thought, we would say that we have had our moments of loving Him, especially in our families and in special people who bring his love into sharp focus by their kindness, love and peace. We may love Him in the beauty of what He created: the warm sun, the beauty of flowers, the taste of excellent food and drink, the miracle of music, the harmony of the seasons...

While Jesus is assuredly in our lives this way, He's also equally present in the people we decidedly do not find pleasant or attractive. He is in the situations about our world where pain and suffering predominate. He is where we would not usually spend much time because it's dangerous or distasteful. He doesn't ask if we are simply able to love him there; he's asking us, "Do you love me there?" Making an active difference in their lives?

We will also explore the varied Eucharistic theologies and liturgical expressions evident in contemporary Christian communions today, but special attention will be paid to the theological and historical dimensions connected with Eucharistic practice as evidenced in the Roman Catholic Mass.


