#### **PASTOR'S REFLECTION**



#### I'm Getting Enthused!

Since last July, Saint Kateri Parish is marking our fifth year as a parish. Where has the time gone?

Over these five years every one of us made amazing efforts to bring together the many committees, ministries, communities and groups of friends and neighbors who formerly had not shared one parish, one name. We welcomed the blessing of our

patron saint, Kateri Tekakwitha, learning so much about her and about her Native American heritage, her heroic Catholic faith and her brothers and sisters who continue to honor her, love her and share her faith in our time. Remember Kateri's canonization, when she was recognized officially as a Saint?

In that same time, we worked assiduously at establishing our own name and position in our town and diocese. We set a standard for collaboration in extremely sensitive and challenging tasks like adjusting the times of our worship. You and I saw the creation of our attractive and artistic emblem, depicting the cross Saint Kateri loved so dearly, formed by waters representing Irondequoit.

Saint Kateri Parish has gained renown for our pilgrimage to worship with Pope Francis, for our participation in the annual Day of Reconciliation and Mercy and for one of our own making the parish proud on the nationally televised competition, "the Voice."

Throughout all of this, parishioners have marked rebirth through Baptism, the Confirmation of our young people's beautiful faith, the holiest of meals in the Blessed Eucharist and the joining of souls in Holy Matrimony. One of our own was ordained deacon and later to the priesthood. So many have received the Church's pastoral care of the sick and the aged, and have gone on from our doors to their eternal home with God. You and I have laughed, sung, cried, recreated and rested together, all because of the uniting presence of the Spirit of God, always in our midst.

Saint Kateri Parish is about those who have touched our hearts, starting with Jesus Christ. In our homes, in our neighborhoods and beyond, his followers continue to bring God's blessings by their love and friendship. It's not hard to recognize in all these gifts the truth that our God has been exceedingly merciful with us all. And in this Jubilee Year of Mercy, a most "Catholic way" to acknowledge and participate is what is known as "public Catholicism:" processions, pilgrimages, joining in public events proudly as members of the Catholic family. In the coming months, I hope all will participate in planned pilgrimages to the Holy Door at Sacred Heart Cathedral because through this type of action God touches hearts, our own and those of others!

So on the weekend of Pentecost this year, all are invited once again to worship our God in a glorious fashion, in the Holy Eucharist, outside where the world can hear and observe. I look forward to participating in this Mass with you and all those you invite! I truly believe God will touch hearts through this celebration and the events planned for our anniversary weekend!






# FAITH FORMATION

### Faith Formation & 2016-17 Registration

Saint Kateri Parish is in the process of growing a vibrant lifelong faith-formation program. We have nearly 375 youth involved from PreK through Gr. 12 in faith formation and sacramental prep sessions. This is not counting the young adults we prepare for marriage, the parents and young children prepared for baptism and the children, teens and adults who are being welcomed into or returning to the church through RCIA or intensive "catch up" catechesis. It also does not include the youth involved in liturgical programs like CLOW, youth music ministry, as altar servers, lectors or communion ministers.

Within such a large parish program, it is essential that we remain focused on our parish mission and the mission of the church. This year we will be making some minor adjustments based on feedback from parents, catechists and staff. Our program options will remain mostly the same as this previous year — a family-based approach that is based on best practices in the religious education/faith formation field and fully endorsed by our pastor, Fr. Paul English.

In education we hear much about engaging the whole child. In faith formation it is essential to engage the whole family. Parents promised during their wedding to lovingly welcome children; and at the baptism, promised to bring them up in the faith. The parish faith formation staff is here to help assist you in this task.



In order to better assist you, we need to know you better. Each family is unique and has important spiritual and social needs as well as gifts to share. This year we will be utilizing a *registration conversation* to help gather information about many of our families.

At our sessions on April 24&25 and May 1&2, we will be meeting with families to register for the upcoming programs, including Sum-

mer Institute for Middle School, Kidz Camp/VBS, Home study, Biweekly programs, and Youth Ministry Leadership and Service programs. We will also register both Catholic and public school youth for the Sacramental Preparation Programs (First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation).

At the end of the regularly-scheduled sessions, staff will lead all families through a presentation describing the program options for the upcoming year and the questions we will be asking to get to know what program and materials would best help your family spiritually. At that time you will be given a copy of the registration form that includes space for basic demographic, health and emergency contact information. (continues on page 7)

There will also be some more open-ended questions for parents and children/teens to indicate what type of program opportunities might be of most interest to them.

Staff and volunteers will be in the Parish Center ready to take your forms when they are complete or answer any questions you may have about 2016-2017 programs. Parents with youth entering grade 1, 2 or Year 1 or 2 confirmation (Gr. 8+) will be invited to a conversation with a volunteer or staff member to discuss in more detail some of the program aspects and the specific needs and interests of the family. Families new to our programs or who are returning after a few years without faith formation will also have a registration conversation. For your convenience, these conversations will have appointment times and can be selected in advance through our website.

We encourage you to register on either April 24/25 or May 1/2 so that we may better plan for the future. We will have open registration days on a weekly basis from May through August. See appointment schedule on our website to select an open slot.




