PASTOR'S REFLECTION



Today is Mother's Day! What a special gift our mothers are! Gods finest blessings and our love to all the women who are moms to us, in many beautiful ways!

Wait For It...

When I was a campus minister at Nazareth College, I used to celebrate the Masses there. One fall we were on the countdown to the end of the liturgical year and the start of another, the First

Sunday of Advent. As the weeks closer I would say, "there are only five weeks to go in this liturgical year..." As the countdown progressed, I began noticing that each time I mentioned it, one young woman turned energetically to her friend and gave a wide-eyed smile. After a few weeks, I had to ask her if she was that excited about the end of the liturgical year, or what was it that caused her excitement? She smiled and said that at that same time her boyfriend was due to return from his semester in Italy! The hardest thing about anticipation is the waiting!

We hear in the amazing vision from the Book of Revelation, "The one who gives this testimony says, 'Yes, I am coming soon." In one week, our parish family will have a double celebration as well. It's the Feast of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit descended upon all believers, giving us a shared gift of courage, wisdom, strength we didn't think we had and deep joy even in the midst of challenge, pain and suffering. Who can do such a thing but God? It's God's Holy Spirit who gathers us, his deeply-beloved children, into the Church family for mutual support, love, encouragement and power.

As we've been announcing for weeks now, Pentecost is the time we celebrate our parish's birthday, and next weekend is our much-anticipated fifth anniversary celebration. We made it five years! Time to rejoice! Time to give thanks for all that God has accomplished through Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish in these five years. So much preparation, hours and hours of meetings, planning, recruiting volunteers, considering the details. The whole community is poised to have a wonderful celebration with our neighbors.

The Feast of Pentecost is a commemoration of the fire of the Spirit descending on the early believers, filling their souls with that same fire that fills yours and mine as we continue the ministry of Jesus in our time. You'll see that our churches are decorated in red, and there will be red liturgical vestments as well. It would be a powerful symbol for us all to wear red clothing, a sea of fire-red worshippers acclaiming the coming of the promised Spirit!

Again this year we've prepared prayer cards or a daily email for you for these days leading up to Pentecost. Pray the daily prayers with the entire parish and know that we are doing this special preparation together as we await the arrival of the Holy Spirit of God's love in our homes, in our lives, in our parish!

Anointing of the Sick - Please call the parish office or see a priest after Mass.


