



PASTOR'S REFLECTION



I've Always Loved The Month Of June

Somehow the northern hemisphere, even if it doesn't respect May as a refuge from winter, always makes for a brilliant month of June! What a relief to see leaves on the trees, sun in the blue sky (when it's not raining) and the ability to go outdoors without a coat!

June is the month when school ends for grade school kids. Summer vacation, if it actually can be a slow-down time, replenishes us. Something of the contemplative comes out in us in the warmer months. We notice trees and clouds and animals and even little bugs, and allow ourselves time to be fascinated by them. I sincerely hope you will be able to have a simple, meditative moment or two each day this month and throughout the summer. It's so good for the soul!

A few weeks ago we concluded our fifth anniversary with that amazing Pentecost celebration. I wrote mentioning the many positive experiences and the sense that God is truly choosing Saint Kateri Parish to make a positive and real difference in the lives of people around us. What a beautiful calling, what an opportunity! When we take these opportunities, we always end up feeling much closer to God.

One thing you may have noticed was that we arranged the Pentecost Sunday Masses in such a way that the 9:00 and 10:00 masses were suspended in order to welcome a representative, and larger than usual crowd "under the tent" for the Pentecost Mass. Unfortunately, the 11:00 time wasn't convenient or possible for some brothers and sisters, so the number of parishioners attending masses at our parish that weekend was lower than usual. You may have noticed that the amount of money in the collection was down significantly that weekend, too. This didn't bother me, though. I had the assurance of our parishioners that they would fulfill their annual commitment, even if they couldn't be there on a given week; they'd just make it up the next time.

I think some mistakenly perceive our financial commitment to our parish as they would going to an event like a movie or a baseball game. There, you pay per performance or game. If you don't go, why would you pay? What's different about being part of a Christian Community is that we commit to one another to support the entire mission of the parish, not just to pay for an occasional event. Parishioners' donations are small installments of a larger commitment – one on which the parish builds our budget.

The end of this month is also the end of the "fiscal year." Please have a look at your records and see if you have fulfilled the commitment you made to your fellow parishioners for this time from last July to the end of this month, and if you have missed a few, see if you can catch up. This would be very much appreciated.



Confirmation Information Session

Liturgy

Church Cleaners tidy and beautify our churches every week. Cleaners are needed at all churches but mostly at St. Cecilia and St. Margaret Mary. Each team cleans on a given day for about 2 hours. The team captain

coordinates tasks like vacuuming, dusting and refreshing.

Altar Servers assist the Priest at weekend Masses and are needed especially at SAT 4:30 PM, 5:00 PM, and SUN 8:00 AM, 11:00 AM liturgies. Flexible scheduling is based on your availability; approx. 2x monthly. 1½-hour training session required.

Funeral Ministers attend funeral Masses at our churches to serve as hospitality ministers and/or Altar Servers. Funerals, usually scheduled MON-SAT mornings fit into a retired persons schedule but all adults are welcome. Schedules are based on your availability; brief training needed.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) distribute the Body and Blood of Christ at weekend Masses and are needed at all SAT and SUN Masses, except 10:00 at CTK. Scheduling is based on availability, but usually asked to serve 2x monthly. A 3-hour training session is required.





