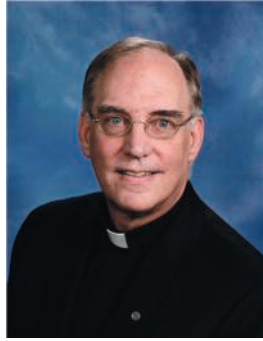

PASTOR'S REFLECTION



It's What's In Your Heart

As this month of June began, a dozen of us made a long pilgrimage to the Shrine of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha in Fonda, New York. It was definitely the most challenging thing I have done physically in my entire life! Of course there were moments of great beauty and fun! By the fourth day it was clear that a

pilgrimage is something you do only with the Lord beside you helping you to make the next mile and the next and the next.

On the fourth day, we had all stopped in a small town to rest and drink some water under a shady tree. Across the street from where we were was a little grocery store. At one point, as I was re-hydrating and trying to get some energy for the next miles, an elderly woman with a quad-cane and a two-wheeled pull cart was crossing the busy street – very slowly. One of the Saint Kateri pilgrims left her bicycle and walked across the street with the bent-over woman and walked a block with her to be sure she'd be OK. It was a touching scene, and one hopes she will remain safe!

Of course, we could have prayed for her and left it at that. We were busy and tired. But instead someone reached out and did a small thing, something she could do, for another human being. It struck me that this is a way of expressing the final line of our Saint Kateri mission: “our vocation to be Christ to the world.”

When a decision to do something “just comes naturally,” Spanish speakers say, “*me nace*,” which means, “it just springs up in me (like a natural spring).” Things spring from our deepest core. If our core is filled with darkness and hatred, awful things seem to come naturally. But the loving heart of Jesus becomes yours and mine when we walk daily with him, talk daily with him, sit quietly as often as we can with him and just enjoy his friendship and peace. What springs up from our deepest core is Jesus!

Saint Kateri herself was given the name “Tekakwitha,” which means “she who bumps into things and walks with her hands in front of her.” Smallpox had killed her family and ruined her eyesight. But the powerful conviction that was Kateri’s of the constant presence of Jesus Christ in her every step, her every moment, gave her a heart filled with joy and love, filled her with very recognizable holiness. When Kateri died at 23 years of age, people told others by word of mouth that “the holy woman has died,” and “the woman who loved Jesus has gone home to him.”

Holiness is not some dramatic, overly-pious thing. Being Christ to the World, our vocation, is not to be anything other than who we are, provided we remain connected to the source of our life in the first place, connected to the One who formed you and me out of love. Then we let what we do spring up from that connection.

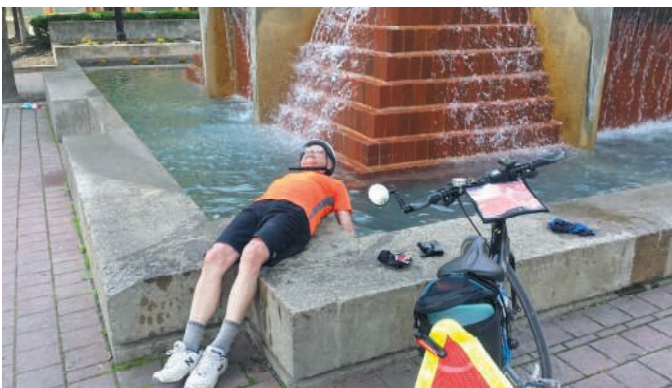
Confirmation Information Session

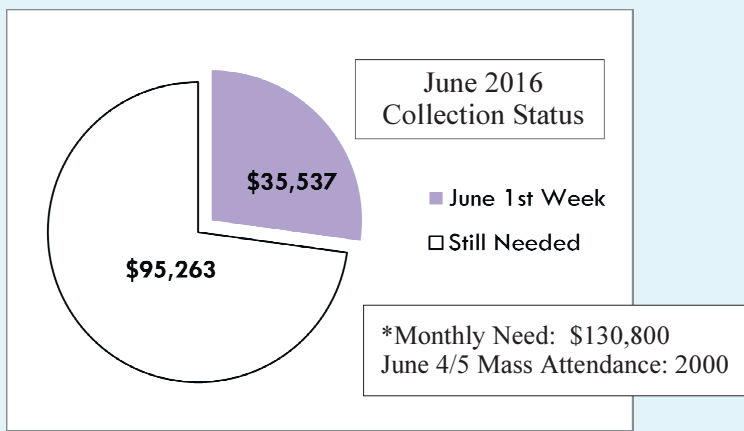

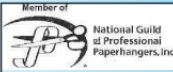
