

PASTOR'S REFLECTION



Sharing Our Spiritual Wealth

Happy Father's Day to all the dads, granddads, godfathers and fathers-to-be! I pray that you will all be blessed. We thank God our dear Father for our fathers, living or dead, who have provided life and example for us with generosity and love.

Two weeks ago I wrote about some of the developments in our parish life. One of those was regarding our Saint Salome church. I would like to take a little more time to bring us all up to date.

In the late winter of this year, Bishop Matano received the advice of his Priests' Council and declared that the Saint Salome church would be relegated to a use other than for Catholic worship. You may have noticed that we continue to use St. Salome for occasional funerals, and will continue to do so for a few months more. It is sacred space, even as we have been given permission to allow it to be rented or sold, after which time, that property will be used for the purposes of the renter or buyer.

As I noted a few weeks ago, Providence Housing has made, and we accepted an offer for the entire St. Salome property. Their intent is to construct housing units like the ones already built on the St. Salome site property, extending their service to more people in the Irondequoit area in need of housing. This plan would include dismantling the present structure in order to build a new one. In order for that to happen, Providence Housing needs to develop and provide detailed plans to the Town of Irondequoit for careful study, scrutiny and approval. When approval is granted, Providence Housing would then secure funding for this project. With so many variables, it is not at all easy to know exact dates for when the steps will happen. I promise to keep you informed as things develop.

There are other Roman Catholic parish communities dealing with very challenging conditions who cannot afford some of the bare essentials in their church buildings in order to serve the People of God in their weekly worship. We have been approached by a parish on the northeast border of our diocese with a request to put to good and holy use some of the furniture and vestments we possess at the St. Salome site. After meeting with the pastor and some parishioners, we realized that allowing these sacred objects to be used by a needy parish in order to worship the Lord would be a beautiful, new home for them. In the coming months, we anticipate other requests for re-locating objects of worship in churches that truly need them, thus honoring the Lord and extending the spiritual life and spirit of St. Salome. We intend to provide photos of these objects in their new home. I have asked that from time to time these be featured in our bulletin. I sincerely hope and pray that our sharing in this way honors Saint Salome and unites us as members of the Body of Christ.
