PASTOR'S REFLECTION

We Are Truly Blessed

This week, the United States celebrates its 240th birthday. With the separation from the rule of the King of England, a new country was born. I can only imagine what it must have been like for the new citizens. There were no established customs, few laws or rules. All that had to be accomplished after the first instance of

independence and establishment as a nation. At that time, the citizens had no ambitions

to be a great power in the world. They were trying to make this "new thing" work and hoping they would make it to 1777!

In those days, as in ours, they were blessed with a land filled with abundant natural resources, plenty of water and a spirit of unity of purpose that aided them in finding a way to create a new country as they went along.

A lot has been made lately of the religious influence in the newborn United States. People had come from a Christian Europe, but in many places, the leaders of the Church and the civil leaders had such a dominance of the economy and the laws that it was difficult to distinguish between them. In the eyes of the founders of this country, no religious body should be established as the de facto government. America would be a nation that welcomed and honored the diversity of faiths and religious practices, and no one religion would dominate the making of the law of the land. In the Constitution, that's what is referred to as the "establishment clause," requiring the separation of Church and State. In particular, they did not want this country to be what England had become.


