The History of St. Salome – Part II

The "Spanish Church" Building 1912 - 1967

Fr. "Ed" Eschrich, Pastor of St. Salome Church 1925-65 (photo at right) was well-known in the Lakeshore area for preaching morals and family values.

Under his leadership a rectory was built, an addition to the school erected and a convent for the teaching Sisters of Mercy purchased. He strongly encouraged festival committees, the drama club, men's and women's club to pursue fundraising for the school and parish.

After these boom years, in the late 1920s hard times came to the area. Residents, mostly laid off factory workers, could barely support their families. Father "Ed" wrote in his diary, "Our finances went to pot. From a Sunday collection of \$150 to \$175 we fell down to \$50 per Sunday. With a



\$90,000 debt and a \$50 per Sunday income, meeting the interest was a real problem. Somehow we managed." Through the power of prayer and hard work the parish managed.



Again in the "Depression Years" of the 1930s and '40s parishioners rallied to care for each other. Meals were made for area families from government surplus, home grown vegetables, rabbits and chickens raised in the yard of the rectory. Children from the school helped by feeding the chickens and weeding the garden. This simple sustenance was given to impoverished residents.

In the years of World War II and after, the parish once again began to flourish and grow. The national trend of GIs moving to the suburbs to raise families increased the population of the lakeshore community. The school thrived under the remarkable direction of Sr. Mary Pierre Van Vliet, principal from 1936 thru 1951.

The 1950s saw an upward surge. The wing of the school was erected and an addition to the church (St. Ann's Shrine) was built. In the late 1950s a new convent was purchased. A large addition was attached to the new convent and the teaching sisters moved in. Also during these prosperous years, the churches of St. Cecilia (c.1949), St. Rita (c.1950) and Christ the King (c.1955) were established and the Church of St. Salome's boundaries diminished.

Then out of the sky on a warm summer night came destruction in the midst of a thundery downpour. A patron leaving a nearby tavern at an early morning hour passed St. Salome and saw thick smoke coming from the building. Returning to the tavern he alerted the bartender who called the local fire department. Point Pleasant, Sea Breeze and St. Paul Blvd. volunteers fought the fire.

In the daylight of that Saturday afternoon, June 16, 1967, Bishop Fulton J. Sheen, on seeing the destruction, commented, "You certainly need a new church." A week later the Courier Journal with the banner "Lightning Bolt Hits St. Salome's" revealed the apparent cause of the destructive fire.

The demolition of the Spanish church began on the morning of April 28, 1968, as parishioners and many in the neighborhood gathered to watch and take pictures of the historic event. The church which had stood on holy ground for 56 years soon lay in rubble. The aging pastor had of 41 year, Fr. "Ed" had retired the year before the fire. A new pastor had been appointed who would lead St. Salome to rebuild for the 3rd time.

Anointing of the Sick - Please call the parish office or see a priest after Mass




