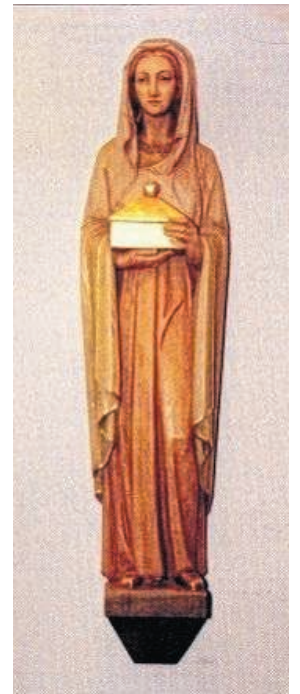

105 YEARS OF CATHOLIC PRESENCE IN IRONDEQUOIT

FAITH OF OUR ANCESTORS, LIVING STILL

Today's Church Building 1969 - 3rd & Final Installment

In 1966, Fr. Walter Fleming became Pastor of St. Salome church and served for seven years as compared with former pastor Fr. Eschrich's forty-one. During this time, the Second Vatican Council changes would impact the global Catholic Church. But St. Salome Parish had an immediate need to rebuild a third time after a lightning bolt destroyed the former church building. Again, under the direction of the pastor, the parish community rallied to raise the needed funds. Edward Ribson, architect of the Chapel at Notre Dame Retreat House and Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, was asked to design a modern structure that reflected Vatican Two changes both interiorly and exteriorly. In the spring of 1969, Bishop Fulton Sheen dedicated the current and final Church with both Fr. Fleming and Fr. Eschrich in attendance.



Throughout the 1970s, many changes in the global and Diocesan Catholic Churches would need to be carried through. Vatican Two required each parish to form a Parish Council along with committees for finance, social action, and liturgy to advise the pastor. Planning at the parish for these changes was interrupted by the death of Fr. Fleming before Christmas in 1973 and a year later, Fr Eschrich. Though they were unable to see the fruit of their work on these changes, they were also spared seeing the desecration of the church sanctuary ten years later.

Shortly after 8:30 on the morning of November 24, 1980 the Irondequoit Police arrived at St. Salome Church to investigate a vandalism complaint. The Police report noted thieves broken in through a window in the choir area. The vandals stole the tabernacle which had been unbolted from its stand directly behind the altar. The altar had been kicked over, candlesticks thrown around and Holy Communion wafers strewn across the sacristy. A follow-up Police report stated that neither the vandals nor the tabernacle were found.

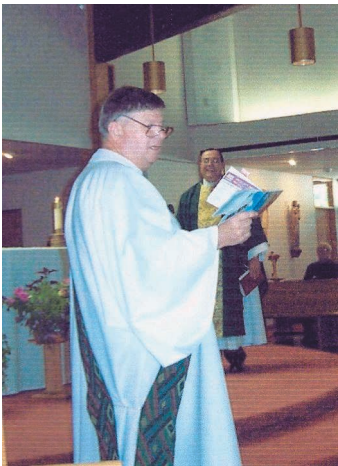
Again, extensive renovations were begun: the tabernacle was relocated to the right side of the sanctuary and a permanent brick altar with a marble top was installed along-side a brick ambo. Relics from Sts. Conrad of Parsham, Oliver Plunkett and John Neumann donated by Fr. Robert McNamara, a long time "weekend assistant," were sealed beneath the altar. On Sunday, March 29, 1981, Bishop Matthew Clark rededicated the new sanctuary and altar.





Through the 1980s other problems ensued. The school, which had been an integral part of the parish since 1921, was in a slow but definite decline. Pastor Fr. Al Delmonte, alarmed by the rising costs and declining enrollment, met with a committee of parishioners. A five year plan to save the school resulted. However, the Diocese recognized the need to close several schools due to these widespread problems. Finally the March 1989 Parish Council Minutes note the Diocese would be closing St. Salome School. In June of that year the final graduation was held.

Declining enrollment was also affecting the church at the national and diocesan levels. In response, in the Diocese of Rochester, Bishop Matthew Clark initiated a Diocesan wide strategic planning process for the New Millennium. St. Salome joined with the other



Irondequoit Churches - Christ the King, St. Cecilia, St. Margaret Mary and St. Thomas the Apostle to begin planning for the future. Years of meetings, discussion and parish gatherings took place among lay people, the clergy and the diocese

In 2008, Irondequoit celebrated 100 years of Catholicism based on the continuous presence of St. Salome church in 1908. Old and young church members had signed up to work on a host of various committees to plan for events. Gala events included a walk to the near-by Irondequoit cemetery to visit the graves and pray for deceased parishioners; a church pageant of its historic times enacted and open to all; a Mass with Bishop Clark followed by a community breakfast in a tent on



the grounds; a float built with a replica of the Spanish Church and parishioners marching in the town July 4 parade as well as manning a booth on the grounds. Finally in the autumn of 2010, close to the feast day of St. Salome, a banquet was held to share supper and memories. It ended with an address by Fr. Norman Tanck, CSB, pastor of the cluster of three parishes (St. Salome, Christ the King and St. Thomas the Apostle). Fr. Tanck led the merger of five Irondequoit churches (the preceding cluster with St. Cecilia and St. Margaret Mary) into one Irondequoit Catholic parish.

The people of St. Salome Church, with their faith and spirit intact, exhibited exemplary Christian charity. Understanding that the future of the Catholic church depended on forming a consolidated Irondequoit parish, families integrated into the new Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish, sacrificing their beloved church building. Through this difficult transition, heartfelt choices had to be made. We are grateful for brothers and sisters who became and continue to be involved in worship, leadership and sharing their deep faith with the Saint Kateri family.

This fall, the town of Irondequoit will be considering a proposal by Providence Housing to purchase the St. Salome property to build senior housing. If accepted, this will add to the St. Salome complex providing more senior residents good, affordable community-based living.

As this 105 year history shows, the families of St. Salome Parish endured the destruction and rebuilding of their church three times. That is their legacy and our legacy. No matter what the future holds, we know our God is with us.

Anointing of the Sick - Please call the parish office or see a priest after Mass

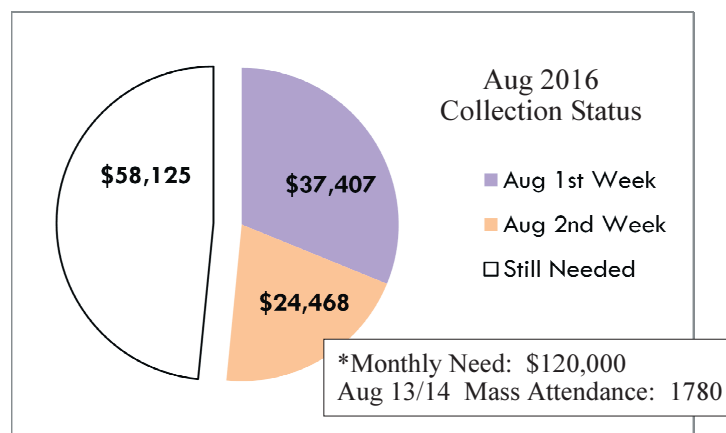

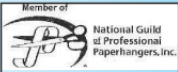
