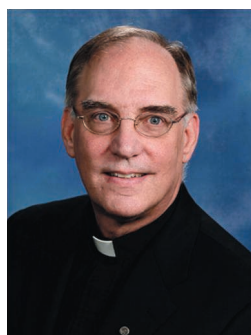

PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Looking Ahead

Now that the summer months are pretty much behind us, it's important to have a sense of where we're going in the coming year. Last week, I let you know that I'm aware of the need, as we move forward as a not-so-new parish, to have a clear sense of what the goal is. Here's what it looks like to me.

In the first years of Saint Kateri Parish's existence, we have consolidated from five communities to one. We have identified the key roles and people to fill them, and in doing so, realize that this is not static; it's a living, breathing thing, so roles continue to be clarified and strengthened for the betterment of the people of our parish.

One of the vital activities any community of people committed to Christ and to one another needs is to be appreciated as equals in the work of discipleship. When Jesus sent the 72 out to preach the Kingdom, heal the sick and cast out evil spirits, he gave all of them the same instructions. They had one purpose for going out. We do, too! We are all bound together by a vision that sees our diverse community on fire with love of Christ and his people. Our mission is to invite and welcome them into this shared discipleship! So we have to be ready for their arrival, ready to show everyone, the people we've known for years and the new arrivals, the loving face of Christ. And Christ depends on all of us to do our part lovingly.

One thing that has become very clear to me as your pastor is that there is a veritable mountain of administrative duties that I am faced with every day. I hope that as we go forward, some of these will be more routine and thus will not take as much time as they have! But this points to another reality: none of us can be behind closed doors in an office and out listening to the ideas and concerns of parishioners at the same time. It's a physical impossibility.

The way I see it, I was ordained to be a priest, a pastoral agent, someone whose life is dedicated to the people God has gifted me with. We all have paperwork and meetings, but these, especially for a priest, cannot be the major focus of his life and activity. This observation brings with it some important implications. I need to re-order the priorities of how I use my time. I'm going to be asking the same question of those on staff as well. And I, for my part, intend to come up prayerfully with a schedule that sees me more present to you and to the people who need the pastoral ministry of Christ in our parish. I ask for your prayers and support in this, and if you have ideas or want to help make this happen, "I'm all ears!"

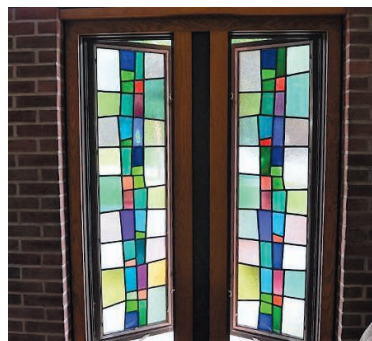

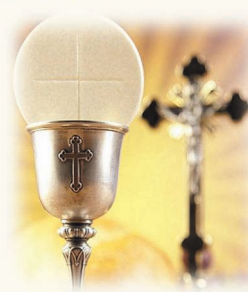

What exactly are Tone Chimes?

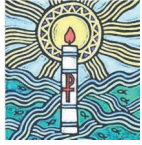
