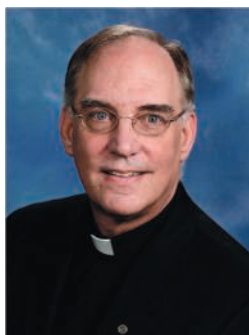

PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Taking Wise Counsel

On August 27, the Saint Kateri Parish Pastoral Council gathered for a morning of prayer and orientation to the very important duties they will carry out for the coming years. There are several new members, discerned in a process held last spring, along with returning members who have served for two or three years. I was very happy to be among them, along with Fr. Morgan Rice.

After a beautiful prayer prepared by Pastoral Council Co-Chair Janet Archibald, our other Co-Chair, Luisa Baars, helped us consider the general purpose and scope of Pastoral Councils in the Roman Catholic Church. You know that a Catholic parish is led by a priest who is Pastor (although these days some are led by a Pastoral Administrator who usually would not be a priest). The law of the Catholic Church requires all parish leaders to take wise counsel from lay members of the parish in financial matters, and that group is called the Finance Council. The leader would also do well not to rely only on his own experience and knowledge for the pastoral matters, and the Church strongly recommends the formation of a Pastoral Council, kind of the “eyes and ears” of the entire parish, who advise the pastor so that decisions he makes are the best-informed they can be. As we explored this, we all realized that it would be very good for the wider parish to know.

The task of the Saint Kateri Pastoral Council, and indeed any Pastoral Council, is “**to research** pastoral matters: ideas and concerns of the community; to consider them thoroughly, and to propose practical conclusions about them. The council’s task is, first of all, to study those matters brought to its attention and shed light on them. Its second task is **to reflect** on them thoroughly, to discern their true nature, to evaluate and to ponder them. Its final task is to draw sound conclusions. The council presents these conclusions to the pastor in the form of **recommendations**. You might call them “the Three Rs.” On Saturday we went on to discuss what areas the Council can concern itself with, and we read and discussed the following:

“The scope of the council is pastoral matters. These may include everything that pertains to the pastor’s ministries of proclaiming God’s word, celebrating the sacraments, caring for the faithful, promoting the mission of the Church to the world, and being a good steward of parish resources. The scope includes all the practical matters of parish life. There is, in short, nothing about which the pastor may not consult the council, apart from faith, orthodoxy, moral principles or laws of the universal Church.”

One of the great things about this is that while members do a lot of what they do outside meetings, they meet the fourth Tuesday evening of each month at 7:00 pm., and parishioners with ideas, questions and concerns are most welcome for the “open forum” portion early in the meeting and, if they wish, to stay to observe. More input means better communication and ultimately better decisions I’m charged with making, so please consider stopping by!

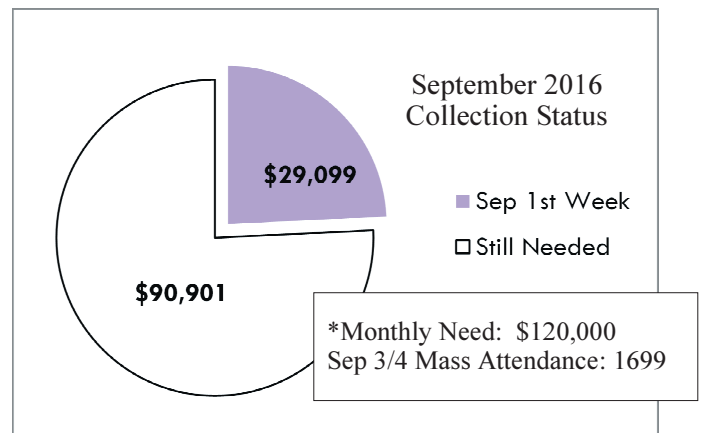

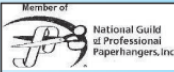
