**PASTOR'S REFLECTION**

**Anticipating A Blessed Year**

Blessings to you this day! It feels important for me to wish you this. You have been such a blessing to me and as we are just beginning this new journey, I want to be sure that I told you so!

This past spring and summer, as I talked with leaders in the parish and the staff, the notion of a “road map” for the coming year kept surfacing. It made me think of our bicycle pilgrimage to the birthplace of Saint Kateri in Fonda, NY. Daily all 12 of us received a sheet with all the instructions we needed to get to the next stopping point, with rest stops, lunch and snacks along the way! It was an important tool for each of us.

We thought of the year in broad strokes. Basically, as I perceive it, we have four main times of special focus, and this will require a lot of our own prayer and working together. Our first is the time we're in now, Fall. On the 24<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of this month, I hope as many parish members as can possibly make it will come to St. Margaret Mary Church to have a conversation about a vision and a mission centered in the living, active Christ, and what actions that implicates. I believe listening to each other prayerfully will show us some important paths as a parish family. Please come!

Yet we as a community of faith recognize that in her last month of pregnancy, our Blessed Mother spent a lot of that time in a holy silence, united with her developing yet unborn Son. Can we journey with our Blessed Mother, cultivating silence in our own busy lives, recognizing Christ within us?

Jesus gives a powerful lesson in his parable of the sheep and the goats, pointing to the mystery that whenever we do a good thing for the least of his brothers and sisters, often for those whom society has decided to write off or ignore, we actually are doing it for Him! Our Lenten time will be a time to participate in loving service to Christ in our needy but dignity-filled brothers and sisters. This will take an amazing amount of planning and dedicated work, but we're planning to serve our Lord!

At Pentecost, heading into the summer months, we intend to sit back together, to reminisce and rejoice at the way that God manifested His presence, His love, His mercy and kindness through our own actions, and how the Spirit of our God made us capable of doing such great things for God's glory.

I'm really looking forward to the year to come. I hope you are too, and that together we can experience the real and deep love of Christ Jesus as we share him with all we meet!

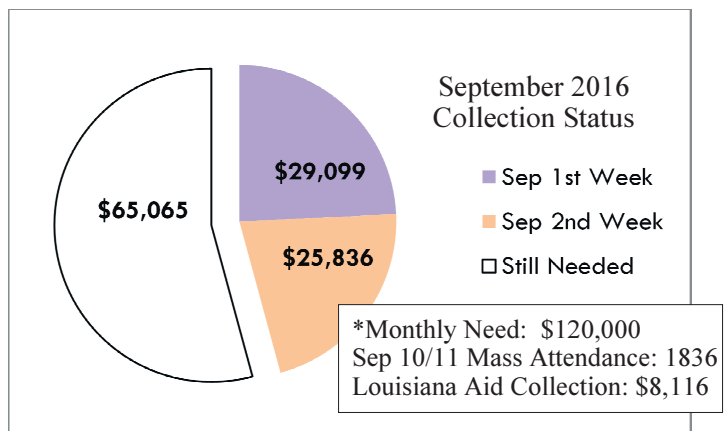
