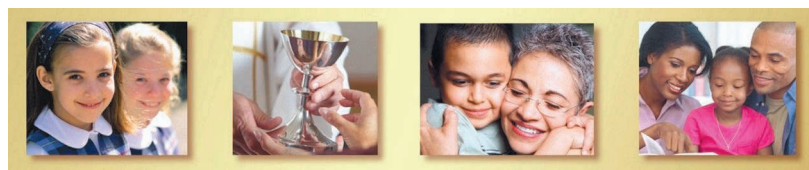

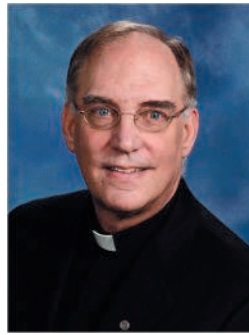

PASTOR'S REFLECTION

The Fruit of Prayer

A couple of weeks ago, I went to Canandaigua for a much-needed week of retreat. During that holy time, I prayed as I seldom have the opportunity or time for in our busy parish. Now, having returned, the spiritual benefits remain with me and motivate me to find – or make – the time my soul needs to continue to pray as I did.

One of the blessings of time away from our daily busy-ness is getting to spend more than a few minutes contemplating what God is saying to your heart in the scriptures in daily Mass. On Thursday of that week, we heard St. Paul write to the Ephesians: “I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, that he may grant you in accord with the riches of his glory to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in the inner self...so that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.” I savored that image for the rest of the day, and it led me quite naturally to a beautiful time of praying for all of you. That felt so right that I have continued it ever since.

St. Paul loved the brothers and sisters in Ephesus the way a father loves his children. He would give his own life for them! This young Christian community made some mistakes and emphasized things in an unbalanced way, but Paul recognized that God was at work among them, and this truth made him profoundly happy and certain that the good they were doing would grow and make a difference, benefiting the world. History tells us that he wasn't wrong!

I started praying for the amazing colleagues with whom I collaborate daily and then for the hundreds of parishioners who participate in all the ministries, study groups and prayerful gatherings that make up Saint Kateri Parish, and I felt overwhelmed at the good that God is accomplishing every day here. What a blessing I realized I had received in being asked to be your pastor!

Looking ahead, I'm confident and unafraid because God has brought us together for his purposes, and because you have responded with such generosity of spirit, such humility and patience at the birthing process of a parish. Now, with new bonds of fraternity, new ministries, new vision, we'll have opportunities to encounter Almighty God as we never have before, if we keep the eyes of our hearts open!

This week as our nation makes its transition from one set of leaders to the next, we as Catholic believers are called to dedicate ourselves to prayer, that our God will reign in human hearts. As we honor veterans, we pray that through the efforts of believers worldwide, we will find a peaceful alternative to war; as our parishioners participate in our annual Giving Tree, that we will cooperate well to benefit people in need. Nine days are left in the extraordinary match by an anonymous parishioner of all increases in CMA donations. May we recognize our participation as a way to extend Christ's ministry, both globally and locally.

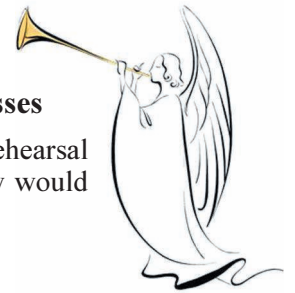
SAINT KATERI SCHOOL
