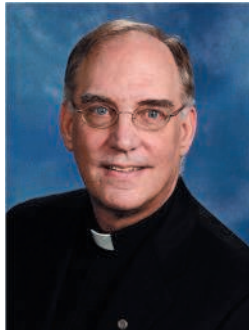

PASTOR'S REFLECTION

So Much To Celebrate

This is a special week for Saint Kateri Parish. Sunday we celebrate the Universal Kingship of Jesus Christ, which used to be called “Christ the King.” We Americans may actually have a hard time with the notion of a king ruling us. Our nation was founded by an act of separation from King George of England, after all! And as king, George was very heavy-handed and not a good ruler.

But we’re not celebrating any earthly king; today we honor Jesus Christ and pledge our very lives to him as our Sovereign, over all the earthly rulers, be they presidents, kings or queens. Their rule may be important, but Christ’s reign is eternal; it is life itself for us who believe!

On Monday, the Catholic Church commemorates the Presentation of the child Mary in the temple. An ancient Catholic celebration, it is also the date on which the Congregation of Saint Basil became a recognized religious order in the Church, and we celebrate it each year faithfully and with great joy. (It also happens to be the anniversary of Fr. Morgan Rice’s priestly ordination.) We honor Mary as the spotless virgin prepared by God to be the mother of His only-begotten Son.

What’s more, on Tuesday, the Church honors Saint Cecilia, who besides being the patroness of one of our beautiful churches, is the patroness of musicians. Think about the wonderful gift of music and song enabling us to pray in such a special way, uniting the deepest senses with the loving heart of our God! May Saint Cecilia continue to bless all our parishioners who play instruments, instruct and sing. Remember: “Who sings, prays twice.”

This week and every week, we as a parish community dedicate ourselves to spreading the Good News that our God is in our midst bringing compassion, wisdom, love, justice and peace, but most of all, bringing Jesus Christ as our brother and dearest friend. This truth, central to our belief as Catholics, ought to be the “background music” to our everyday lives. All that we do ought to focus on Jesus, helping others grow in their relationship with him.

Of course, Thursday, we pause to say “thank you” to God for all our blessings. Our God reminds us that blessings are always meant to be shared; in fact they are better enjoyed when we share them. Think this Thanksgiving of a way to share your blessings, not only this week, but every day!

As this week ends, we move into what you might call, “Catholic New Year.” Next Sunday Advent begins, and I am asking everyone to honor Jesus Christ by honoring his Mother, Mary, as she made the quiet preparations for his birth. The theme I am asking us all to take deeply into our being is “Responding with a Quiet Heart.” Let’s make it our Advent observance to keep the unborn Christ and his beautiful mother in the forefront of our hearts. Look for opportunities to stop by church and pray before Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, and other quiet ways to prepare for the arrival of Mary’s Child and our Saving Lord.

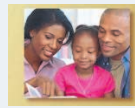

Responding with a Quiet Heart

Blessings to each of you!

Before the full force of Christmas overwhelms us, I am inviting each of us to embrace Advent in a tender way. Just as our Blessed Mother quietly prepared for the birth of Christ, let us as a whole parish family try a different way of preparing, “Responding with a Quiet Heart.” Wait, Watch, Listen.



For these four weeks, you are invited to spend a few minutes each day with the Lord in silence. There are many ways to sit in the “classroom of silence.” Choose a way that is easy and works for you. Know that God is waiting for you, looking for you, very happy that you and He will have this time together to deepen your mutual relationship.

How?

Slow down and be quiet.

Find a personal sacred space – a comfy chair in your home, or a minute of silence with your family before dinner. Turn off your gadgets for five minutes a day or take a walk in a quiet neighborhood or nature.

Stop in Church or the Adoration Chapel to visit the Lord

Whatever you do, make it a daily habit to meet with the Lord. If a day gets missed, keep going – it’s worth the blessing.

Looking into the faces of young children, we see the excitement and joy build anticipating Christmas day. Like our Mother Mary, let us allow Christ to come into our hearts and prepare for the birth of our Savior. Wait, Watch, Listen.

Feast of St. Andrew Dung-Lac & Companions, Nov 24

St. Andrew Dung-Lac' and Companions were canonized by Pope John Paul II in 1988. The Companions are 117 martyrs, primarily Vietnamese, but also from Spain and France. Andrew Dung-Lac was a diocesan priest born in North Vietnam in 1795 in a poor and pagan family. At the age of twelve, his family met a catechist who gave them food and shelter. He embraced the Christian faith and was baptized Andrew in Vinh-Tri. He studied theology and was ordained a priest in 1823. He was tireless in his preaching, often fasting and living a simple and moral life. In 1835 he was imprisoned with other priests a number of times under emperor Minh-Mang, but obtained his freedom in exchange for money. He was rearrested in November 1839, along with Peter Thi, and taken to Hanoi where both suffered dreadful torture. Both were beheaded December 21, 1839.

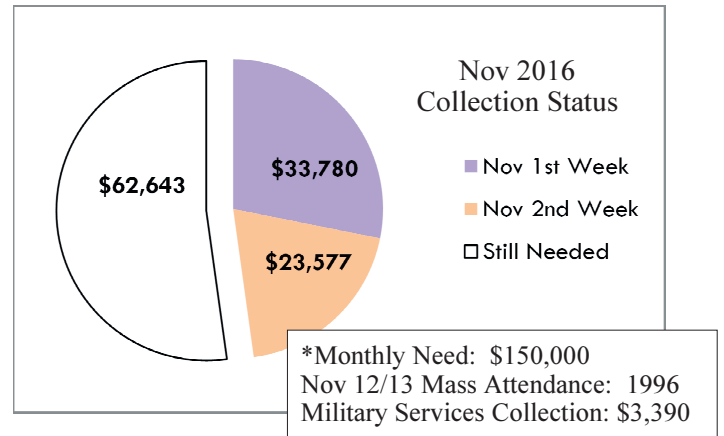

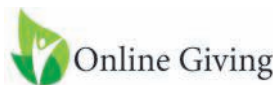
