PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Quietly, Peacefully

Rest. That is something few people get in the month of December. "I'll rest when I get the shopping done!" "I'll rest when I get all of my Christmas cards out!" We put off rest, even at night, because there's one more show to watch on TV or one more game to play on one of our many electronic devices... Rest, relaxation, quiet

and peace...things that we borrow time from in December. I had a friend who said, "I wish there were 25 hours in a day." But then she added, "No, maybe not; I'd just fill that extra hour, too!"

Rest, allowing our body and our mind – our spirit – to experience quiet and peace, is the way our soul and body repair, gain strength and clarity, become healthy! Of course there's exercise and good eating habits, all those things we always think of – but doing what appears to be "nothing?" That might be the biggest discipline challenge of them all! And how they pay back!

I'm sure the Virgin Mary was taking advantage of every opportunity, three weeks before her baby was due, to rest, to allow her body to repair, to enable her spirit to dwell deeply with the Child who is God developing in her womb. How is your preparation for the Christ Child going so far? Is it possible that he is on your mind as much as he was on Mary's mind? She anticipated a miraculous, holy birth. When we think about Jesus, do we anticipate anything special? Do we look forward to seeing him face to face and having something about our life change for the eternally better?

Saint Augustine is known to have said, "My heart is restless until it rests in Thee." Have you found that your restlessness begets more restlessness? How different are we, really, from little children who, having been put into their crib and tucked in, fight sleep and do everything they can to stay awake? Why, you ask yourself, would a kid not want to sleep? It's such a pleasure! It makes no sense!

God is calling us, as children of so wonderful a Father, to rest in Him, to spend restful, quiet time with His Son in Eucharistic adoration, in meditation, listening to His "still, small voice" in the cavernous silence we seldom allow ourselves to experience! "Quietly, peacefully, let me rest in you…" These words of the song are a reminder of this necessary, delicious staple of our spiritual bodies, and help us get past the child's refusal to rest, knowing that a wonderful gift awaits us when we allow ourselves to be enfolded in the arms of our loving God.

This Advent is a short four weeks. We have planned a number of opportunities to respond to the frenzied pace that swirls around in this season, but responding with a quiet heart. It is there, in the quiet, that the lover of our souls is waiting to share his love with us. A schedule of these opportunities has been published. I'll hope to spend some time in the quiet with you!

Notes:

- 1. 2016 offertory revenue decreased 2.2% for the first 3 months of the fiscal year as compared to same period in 2015 and is 5% below budget. The reduction in offertory revenue closely approximates reduction in Mass attendance. Please be mindful of Saint Kateri Parish as you consider future charitable giving.
- 2. 2016 school revenue is down as compared to 2015 as kindergarten enrollment dropped as a result of Irondequoit Central School offering full day kindergarten.
- 3. Personnel costs are near budget this quarter but higher than September 2015 due to two additional weeks plus standard cost of living increase.
- 4. Non-operating expense for 2016 includes capital purchases of about \$176,000, mostly for CTK air conditioning and roof upgrade (total project estimate = \$340,000), partially offset by an increase in market value of investments of about \$77,000.
- 5. Our parish supports Catholic education by subsidizing the operation of Saint Kateri School. Saint Kateri and our five former parishes subsidized the Monroe County Catholic Schools' System, prior to the school's July 1, 2012 reversion to the parish, at a level greater than our current school subsidy.
- 6. Investments-Designated are funds reserved for future needs. Bequests greater than \$10,000, not otherwise restricted, are invested for future renewal and replacement of buildings and equipment. Parish policy allows spending up to 4% of the average investment funds annually for Parish capital needs. In addition, Diocesan policy mandates that sales of property also be reserved for non-operating use. Reserving funds is prudent fiscal stewardship in order to avoid emergency fundraising to replace large capital items such as roofs and heating systems. Designated Education investments will be used for future Catholic education costs. None of Saint Kateri Parish's reserve funds are from offertory receipts. All offertory receipts are used for parish operating costs.
- The parish remains free of debt, managing cash flow prudently to cover the cost of daily operations with revenue from collections, tuition, donations, and grants.




