

PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Community On A Mission

Think about it: the Father had a vision for his beloved children and decided to set out on a mission to bring that about. We have been hearing it, particularly in the first readings of this Advent season: a vision of peace on Earth, a vision of former enemies enjoying each other's company, a vision of all people resting in the presence of our Glorious God! But

in order to accomplish this wondrous vision, Jesus, God's Son took up the mission: to preach the Good News of the Kingdom of God present among us, a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love, and peace.

Here at Saint Kateri Parish, we share this hope, and a vision energizes us as we live our daily lives, hoping for "the day of the Lord" when the Kingdom will be clearly present and the world renewed, as God has always intended. One way we declare that we intend to work toward this vision is by *inviting and welcoming* all people to come to know Jesus Christ. These next few weeks in particular will provide us some special opportunities to live this mission. Christmas is a time when people visit family and come to church with them. Many people feel God's call in their heart in a special way in this season. Many family members joyfully attend Masses when their little ones take part in Christmas pageantry.

We all have our accustomed seats in church, and a certain level of activity. People will show up very early for Christmas Masses and reserve pews and perhaps talk a bit more than we are used to. Our usual, comfortable routine will probably be there for us again in a week or two! Still, the presence of these brothers and sisters is a wonderful, blessed opportunity for us to take up Christ's mission, reaching out *to invite and welcome* them into the warmth of our parish, helping them feel at home – for truly, this *is* their home – so they can know, the way we already know, that "all are welcome" is so much more than a song we sing.

Each year, God puts before us a tremendous opportunity to assist Him in repairing strained or broken relationships with the Church, with families, with God Himself. God's children are here among us. Their needs, their concerns, their joys and their troubles are for us to share lovingly. I hope we all take the opportunity God will be giving us to do something that Pope Francis does so well: look people (especially people we don't know or haven't seen for a long time) in the eye and take a real interest in who they are. There are many small kindnesses we can do for our neighbor in the course of a Mass! If just showing up and entering a church was difficult for the person sitting next to one of us, our kindness and real concern will soften that a great deal, and Christ will have worked through our actions in a powerful way.






Operation Christmas Child by Susan D'Aprix

Our Christmas Gift



Christmas is a time of giving and receiving. As people of faith we know we have received the most wonderful of gifts, Our Lord Jesus Christ, given for our salvation.


We have an opportunity to give back, albeit in a small manner. As a member of the Legion of Mary I know that we have no greater gift to present to Jesus, than the gifts



The Parish will acknowledge your gift by describing the assets contributed (number of shares, name of stock, etc.) and the date the securities were received. You, the donor, will be responsible for establishing the value of the gift for tax purposes. Fair market value of the stock can be determined by taking the mean of the highest and lowest selling price on the date of the gift.
