



**PASTOR'S REFLECTION**

**Rejoice, Everybody!**

What family is unfamiliar with this question: “Are we there yet?”

When families are traveling along to an important event, time seems to crawl, doesn't it? For children, whose concept of time is much more limited, sitting strapped into their seat for more than 10 minutes can seem a lifetime! Thus the question: “Are we there yet?”

One can answer in many ways, of course. Logic: “If we were there, we wouldn't still be moving!” Cold truth: No.” Or, as a friend of mine does, you can respond with a concept that is sufficiently vague that will quell the whining queries: “Five minutes, kids!”

When we are waiting for Christmas to come – four weeks of quiet, prayerful time, some of it spent in doing penance in preparation for the commemoration of the birth of God-in-the-Flesh – can seem like an impossible amount of time. That is surely why, by December 25, most of us have been to Christmas parties numbering in the double digits! And still, in our prayer life, accompanying the Virgin Mary in her last weeks of waiting, wondering, hoping, praying, sometimes struggling but always with love for the One who is to come, the People of God wait. This third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday. *Gaudete* means “Rejoice, everybody!” You see, when you know it's a four-week wait, and you've waited prayerfully and somewhat uncomfortably, the third Sunday means that we're almost there! “Five minutes, kids!” Although there is still a short wait ahead, the time is so near now, we can almost taste it!

With this year coming to an end, we look back, if only to wonder how it went by so quickly. We say that now, but as it was progressing, life was happening, in all its ups and downs, its joyous moments and its tragedies. Every step of the way, you and I were accompanied by Jesus Christ, our faithful companion who promised never to leave us or forsake us. He said, “Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the world.” He is, in a way, a “permanent fixture” in our lives, whether we recognize his presence or not. And, lest we forget, he is Love, God's most beautiful Word made flesh. Emmanuel dwelling among us personally, present with us as the Savior of the World.

As you and I contemplate the movement of our lives, whether 2016 brought you only joy or only sorrow, or, like most, if it brought a mix of the two, let us take some quiet moments this week once again to look at our experiences and search for the presence of Jesus there. I bet you'll find him. He comes to us in need – the needs of other people and often in our own need. He comes to us all the time in hard challenges. In those times, when we were feeling the weight of such heavy responsibilities, he's been there, encouraging us, giving us the grace of wisdom, subtly guiding our hearts and our minds.

Oh, we do long for the coming of Christ. Today he's inviting us to open our eyes to see him in very unexpected ways – and to rejoice!
