1. What have you accomplished this month? What activities have you sponsored? (please include numbers)

**Communion Services:**

We had scheduled 22 Communion Services.

**AARP:**

The Drivers Training Course was May 15<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>. 24 Participants took the safety course. This completed the season. Our next training class will be in September.

**GST:**

For the month of May:

Rides Given:	162	-15 rides over last year
Clients Served:	28	-5 over last year
Donations:	\$459	-220 over last year

Year to date:

Rides Given:	792	-27 over last year
Clients Served:	132	-20 over last year
Donations:	\$2,229	-\$482 over last year

The decline in these figures reflect seniors who have passed away/or have moved out of the area into family residents or in nursing homes.

We also have many seniors who rely on our services several times a week.

We registered 5 new seniors to our ministry in May.

**ALPHA for Seniors:**

Alpha for Seniors started on May 5<sup>th</sup>. We have 10 participants who have been to previous sessions and are enjoying what we have to offer. The final class will be on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. In July we will start **ALPHA Senior 101** and will also be able to begin another new class.
