- 1. What have you accomplished or worked on this month? What events or activities have you sponsored or presented? (please include numbers of participants and helpers)
- a. St. Kateri Parish and School Net Operating Income September \$49K and YTD \$101K. Highlights include:
 - 1. Regular Collections of \$338K are averaging \$26K per week (13 weeks) plus \$3.6K for Holy Day.
 - September Enrollment = 197 (increase from 194 prior year).
 PreK 3 and 4 year-olds = 89, Kindergarten Grade 5 = 108.
 Registration Fees \$19.5K, Extended Care = \$9K.
 - 3. Rental Income YTD \$9K from external organizations, including BOCES, Sisters of St. Joseph, and American Tower.
- b. Fundraising Net Income YTD (after expenses):
 - 1. Golf \$8K (½ Parish; ½ PBA Nightstick Club), St. Pauly Box \$1K.
 - 2. Plans include: October 4th Walk a Thon, \$ave Around ROCHESTER, Book Fair, Bill Gray's and Niagara Candy.

- a. The Bonadio Group and the Diocese of Rochester conducted a site visit at the Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish and School on September 15, 2017. The current rating is GREEN.
- b. St. Salome's: Sale to Providence Housing closed on 9/8/17. After deducting operating expenses and legal fees associated with the property, proceeds from the sale were deposited into short term and long term investments.
- c. Saint Thomas the Apostle: On 9/19/17, the Town Board of Irondequoit voted against re-zoning an application submitted by Capstone Development for market rate apartments at the former school.
