1. What have you accomplished or worked on this month? What events or activities have you sponsored or presented? (please include numbers of participants and helpers)

Friday Oct 14th -“Greet-Meet-Eat” event at NFC

Over 150 neon orange invitation cards were sent to all who joined the parish since August of 2015; OR who had a baby baptized; OR went through the RCIA process.

All of these invitees also got a phone call the week prior to the event. Three of the baptismal team families were on the event planning, and also sent e-mails to those who had a child baptized. There were games and art projects for children, as well as teens and adults to help greet, and with food. So there were several forms of outreach and contact, as well as lots of and enthusiasm that went into the planning. All who came had a good time – about 35 people were there, including staff, but only 4 new families! It was disappointing that more didn't attend, but many were most appreciative of the outreach and invitation.
