Faith Formation & Youth Ministry Programs

Sacraments

Confirmation preparation is underway. We have 44 youth in the second year of preparation with April 20, 2016 celebration; and 45 youth in the first year of preparation.

First Reconciliation Make up sessions in Jan and Feb for the few families had schedule conflicts or missed the sessions in the fall. Under Diocesan policy [and Canon Law] youth need to be prepared for First Reconciliation before First Eucharist.

First Eucharist (Communion) preparation begins in February. Celebrations will occur at regular weekend liturgies at the end of April and beginning of May.

RCIA sessions will begin the Period of the Catechumenate on January 3. We will continue meeting on Saturday am and begin dismissals from Mass during Lent. We have 5, possibly 6, adult participants and 1 child. We also have two younger children just for Baptism at the Vigil.
