#### **Faith Formation & Youth Ministry Programs**

The next intergenerational session will be Mar 6&7. This has been collaboratively planned with ISM, Liturgy and Music. We will have a pasta meal, a guest speaker for adults, youth will have time with their teachers, and intergenerational discussion time. There will also be an optional service project component prior to the meal time.

Plans are underway for the April 10&11 intergenerational session which will include stations where parents and children can interact together. It is being collaboratively planned with faith formation and Sarah Schmerbeck and Karin Spears to include the Spring festival activities.

#### Sacraments

*Confirmation* preparation is underway. We have 44 youth in the second year of preparation with April 20, 2016 celebration; and 45 youth in the first year of preparation. Our youth in the second year are entering the Immediate prep phase – a more spiritual and intense period to prepare them to receive the sacrament and to live out the graces they will receive.

*First Eucharist (Communion)* preparation begins February 22. It includes a series of workshops for parents and children to help the families work together at home on the material. All youth are concurrently enrolled in Faith Formation or Catholic School. We also have a group of youth who are receiving intensive catechesis since they have been out of faith formation for a few years who will also be making their First Communion. Celebrations will occur at regular weekend liturgies at the end of April and beginning of May.

**RCIA** sessions continue dismissals from Mass during Lent. We have 5, possibly 6, adult participants and 1 child. We also have two younger children just for Baptism.

#### **Adult Formation**

Joe Kelly will be back in Lent to offer a 4 week series on "Why do bad things happen to good people" based on the Church Year of Mercy. The sessions will be Tuesdays from 7-8:30 PM at CTK, Feb 23, March 1, 8, and 15. Free. Spread the word!
