1. What have you accomplished or worked on this month? What events or activities have you sponsored or presented? (please include numbers of participants and helpers)
 - Faith Formation Intergenerational Session - 10/2&3 – Sunday – 127 youth enrolled plus at least one parent each, Monday 126 youth enrolled plus at least one parent attended, 9 adult volunteers, 1 youth volunteer
 - Dr Joe Kelly Series on Islam - 10/6, 10/13, 10/20, 10/27 – 80-110 attendees, refreshments by 3-4 volunteers over series
 - Kidz Camp/VBS – 10/10 – 25 Children, 3 staff, 1 adult volunteer, 5 youth volunteers
 - Youth Ministry Kickoff and Bonfire – 18 youth, 6 adult volunteers
 - Marriage Enrichment Event – 10/15 – (collaboration with Marriage Encounter) – 6+ Saint Kateri Couples joined the 10+ Marriage Encounter Couples (which included Saint Kateri parishioners as well as those from around Diocese) at the event for Mass, renewal of Vows, a shared meal and presentation
 - Confirmation Sponsor Meeting - 24 attended
 - Youth ALPHA – Biweekly Sunday Start date 10/16 – 3 youth, 1 staff, 3 volunteers
 - Faith Formation Biweekly 10/17 – 98 Students enrolled, 8 adult volunteers, 3 youth volunteers
 - ALPHA – Thursdays start date 9/22 – New participants each week as well as people returning –attendance ranges from 7-17, 10 adult volunteer helpers taking turns, 2+youth helpers
 - First Reconciliation Prep – 10/24 – about 75 youth plus parents, 2 volunteer helpers, 1-3 youth helpers
