



#### PASTOR'S REFLECTION

#### **Feeling Gratitude**

October is one of my favorite times of the year. The cooler air, the colorful leaves on the trees, the smell of wet earth and leaf piles ... There's a special beauty to autumn here in upstate New York that many others don't experience. I find myself in a little

better mood to look around and take in the beauty, and that always leads me to stop and breathe and thank God for all I see and feel.

In the last few weeks, our parish has begun **Alpha**, a gathering of people interested in exploring our Catholic faith a little more in their lives. I've been attending and I must tell you, it's another of those graced moments to think about our God's love lived out in our lives, and to hear others as they share their questions, thoughts and experiences in the most relaxed atmosphere you could imagine! I always come out of these conversations with a new insight. You are most welcome to participate, too: every Thursday at 6:30 PM in CTK Room 137.

Probably the most important insight for us as Christians is getting to know Christ Jesus as a loving companion and friend who always "has your back," as some people say. Somehow, we Catholics understand this at a deep level, even if we're known for not talking about this wonderful relationship. We often rely on symbols to talk for us. It's like saying, "I love you." Some find it hard to say to another, but whether with hugs or acts of kindness or just knowing what pleases or relaxes the other, they often say "I love you" loudly and clearly! When it comes to our Catholic experience of faith in Jesus, we are so blessed to have more than a symbol: we have His very Body and Blood, shared with us each time we participate in the Mass. We hear our God Himself speak to us through the voice of lectors and ordained persons when we hear the Scriptures proclaimed in liturgy. We know His mercy when we seek reconciliation in Sacramental form -- Jesus Himself saying "I forgive you." We are a Sacramental people, so blessed with these holy yet homespun ways for our God to show us His presence, His love.

Jesus is the center of all we are and all we do, both as individual Christians and as a parish. I find myself in these beautiful autumn days stopping and thinking about this parish family and I feel flooded with gratitude to Christ Jesus Himself, who gathers us together, gives us the gift of Himself -- and of each other -- and He walks alongside us as we seek His face, His loving will, His peace and mercy together. What a privilege for me to be part of that walk with you. Thanks to our God, and thanks to you!


#### **Financial Peace University**



#### 1<sup>st</sup> Grade 9-11 Remembrance

Every year Nancy Wilson, 1<sup>st</sup> Grade teacher, reads a very special book about 9-11 and discusses the

importance of honoring, and never forgetting, the many heroes who lost their lives that day. The class then says a prayer and creates Remembrance booklets where each child either writes or illustrates their thoughts about 9-11. There's not a lot of details shared because of their young age, but Ms. Wilson impresses upon her students that the heroes whom our country has lost, as well as their families, who are still hurting, all need our prayers. The children are invited to write a prayer, to be placed in the Prayer Jar that sits in the classroom, for all the men and women lost in the tragedy and their families. All of



those prayers, and any others in the Prayer Jar, are kept close in their hearts throughout the year in their daily intentions. The class also learns about the present-day heroes who continue to have fundraisers and special activities to raise money for the victims and families. Although the students are young, their empathy and genuine concern are visible, and a beautiful thing to experience. The Saint Kateri School community also remembers the victims and their families when they gather together for morning prayer.

# High quality child care can be the start of a bright future for parents and children:

Our parish will have the opportunity on October 15/16 to sign a letter in support of child care assistance for parents who work but have low incomes. This assistance helps parents to be more productive and reliable workers, and also allows them to place their child in an accredited child care setting. High-quality early childhood development and learning interventions serve as a buffer to the negative effects of poverty and provide a foundation for future success with lifelong benefits, particularly for the poorest and most vulnerable children. Studies have shown that children enrolled in high quality early childhood programs are more likely to graduate from high school, hold a job, make more money and be less likely to commit a crime than their peers who do not participate.

Of course, if your schedule is better suited to minister at the weekend Masses, consider being a Lector, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion or even Altar Server!






