



Join in the Saint Kateri Parish "Offering of Letters" to Prioritize Children by Increasing the Childcare Subsidy Allotment in the County Budget

October is Respect Life Month. Real people's lives – lives for whom Jesus Christ died to save – are deeply affected by whether people of faith do three things:

- 1. Care about what's really happening. That means we don't look away or remain uninformed.
- 2. Pray for those who are in danger, but also for ourselves to have the love and courage necessary to make a difference, and
- 3. Go, make a difference, abandoning ourselves in the hands of Christ, our God, completely trusting Him who is the absolute proof of God's love for the world.

Saint Kateri parishioners, together with local faith communities, have the opportunity to sign a letter addressed to the County Executive Office asking to increase the childcare subsidy allotment in the county budget. Increasing subsidies for childcare would give more low-income working families access to high-quality care that would be safe, reliable and would help prepare their children to enter kindergarten ready to succeed in school. For parents, this subsidy allows them to focus on their work, schooling, or job training:

The Rochester Poverty Initiative's 2016 report states that Rochester continues to be the 5th poorest city in the United States, among the top 75 metropolitan areas. Compared with cities its size, Rochester now ranks 2nd in overall poverty (33.8%),

1st in child poverty (52.5%) and 1st in the rate of extreme poverty. This poverty is devastating with lifelong effects.

Please be the voice that these children and their families do not have and sign your letter today. Help break the cycle of poverty by investing in our poorest and most vulnerable children. Letters and information will be available online to print and in church next weekend. Your signed letters will be collected as an offering with prayer at next weekend's liturgies.


Creating A Safe Environment (C.A.S.E.) Training & Retraining for Volunteers


