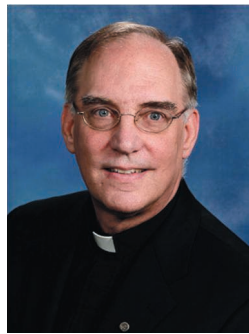

## PASTOR'S REFLECTION

### ***Being Christ To The World***

When we hear and read about hurricanes along the Atlantic coast, about devastating earthquakes, about the results of wars, conflicts and terrorist activities, it's hard to see how hope comes into the picture. I think back to this summer when I saw the image of a tiny child who had drowned while trying, with his family, to escape war-torn Syria. While a photographer was there to capture that tragic moment, similar tragedies are occurring in lives across our globe every day.

So, what gives me hope? What strengthens me to face another day? What keeps all the awful news from overwhelming me? Well, as an individual, as "one person against all this evil," I'm not powerful. I'm really unable to do anything to help myself, much less anyone else. But that doesn't bother me at all because I'm not "one person against all this evil," I'm a member of an organization that daily reaches out to suffering persons, daily draws attention to what individuals and groups can accomplish for good, daily advocates with lawmakers and leaders for the common good. I am a member of the Body of Christ as a Roman Catholic, and that membership encourages me and strengthens me and all the baptized to live out our shared vocation to be Christ to the world.

I am so encouraged by the work of the Catholic Church throughout the world and right here at home. Catholic Relief Services, an arm of our Catholic Church, reaches across the globe to find Christ's poor and suffering and does real and effective good to save lives and bring the endangered to safety. Missionaries and lay volunteers share their talents in health care, teaching and helping families. Our Catholic Church is involved, often too quietly, in so much good happening in this world! And that means that you and I are part of all this action for good!

Our parish mission calls us to embrace and celebrate our vocation: to be Christ to the world. In order to do this, we need to seek every opportunity to either do these things ourselves or support those who do them in our name. In our household, the fathers and I are praying about and discussing how we will participate this year in the Catholic Ministries Appeal, and we're encouraged by the fact that a generous donor has once more offered a wonderful incentive for us all to do so: he has committed to matching whatever increase individuals or families give as compared to last year.
