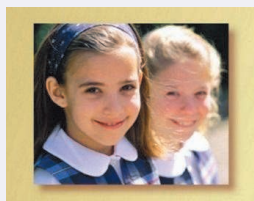

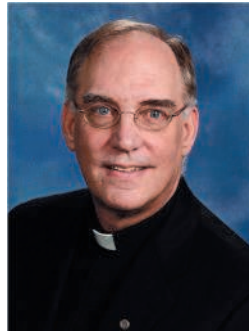

PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Anticipation...

Happy New Year!

Yes, the Church begins its Liturgical Year this weekend, a way to tell the story of God’s deep concern for his beloved children, of our fall and salvation and of the life that awaits us after this earthly existence, all in one year! This year you and I will be meditating on the rich stories of the Gospel of St. Matthew at most of the weekend Masses.

By this time in her married life, Mary was in her eighth month, carrying the miraculous child for whom God had chosen her to be the mother. Try to imagine all that she and Joseph were feeling, both emotionally and physically! Moms will tell you that they are less likely to go out and do all the things they normally do. The baby is becoming nearly full-size. Still, there is a lot of preparation to do: preparing the house, getting a room ready and having clothing and “baby things” for him when he arrives. Then there’s the spiritual preparation. She has been in relationship with this developing child for eight months, intimately feeling his movements, his physical growth, sharing her emotions and her nourishment with him. This is a time of deep reflection, of amazing love, of wonder and of pondering what the future might be.

Oh, and they had to travel! The whole nation of Israel had to go back to their ancestral homes to participate in a mandatory census. Joseph’s family was from Bethlehem, many miles by foot and donkey from their home in the northern city of Nazareth. With Mary eight months pregnant. Imagine it! Imagine how Joseph must have felt for his dear wife and this wonderful child. Would they be alright? What would they find along the way?

At Saint Kateri Parish this four-week period of Advent, we want to do something quite different from the world around us. Since Thanksgiving, the secular world has skipped right to Christmas! You know all too well what I mean. How hard is it not to get drawn into the center of the swirl of frenetic activity! Catholic experience tells us that when we skip the time when the Blessed Mother was pondering in her very soul the miracle taking place within her, we really miss something rich, vital for our faith in her Son.

For many Catholics, this relationship with Jesus is something carried within, perhaps not detected often, yet it is there. From our birth, but particularly in our baptism, we have been made one with Christ within us, whether, like a pregnancy, we know it or not! Let us all take the amazing Advent journey of silencing our hearts, becoming aware of that profound presence within us. Spend some time before Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, ponder Christ’s presence in ourselves, in our family members, in the beauty of this Earth... all things we tend not even to be aware of when we’re in the “shopping race!” It will do our spirits good to experience the anticipation Mary and Joseph did. Let’s do this together!

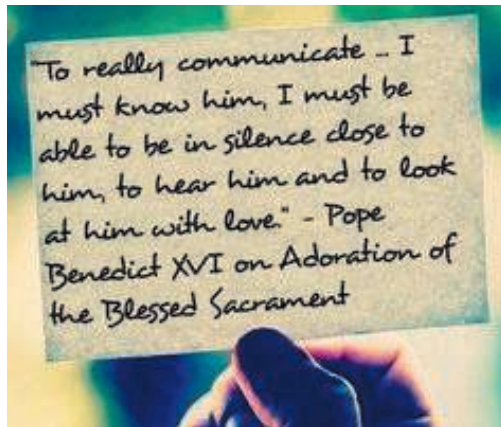

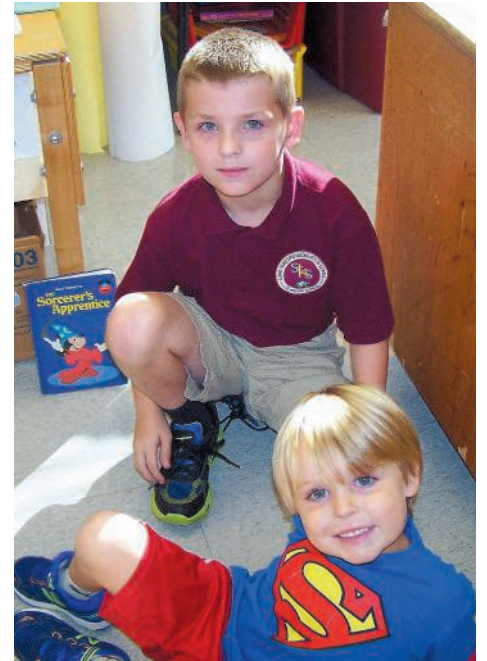


Calling All Prayer Partners!

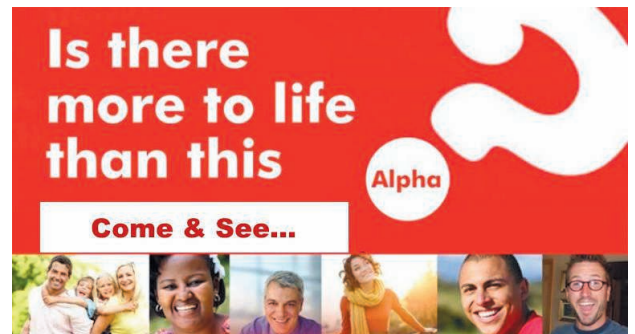

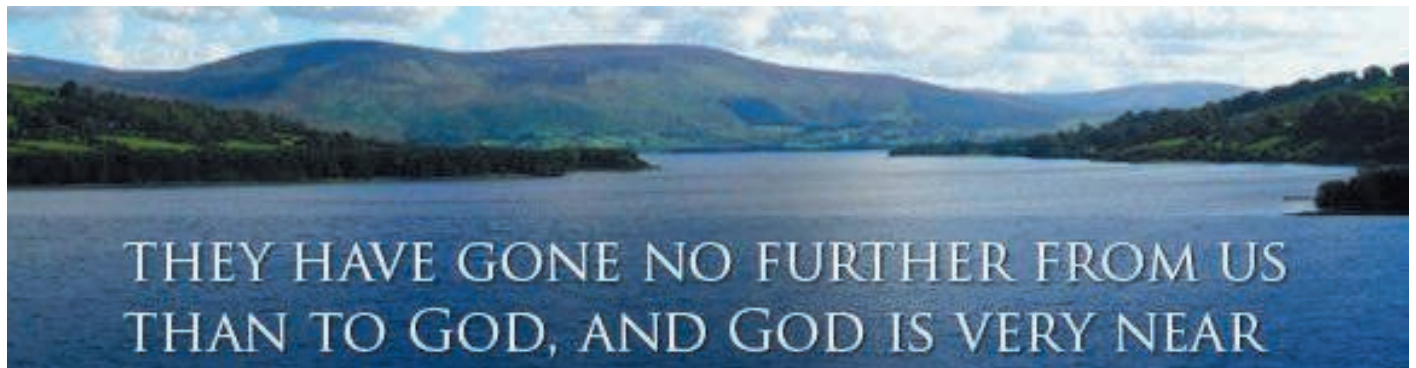

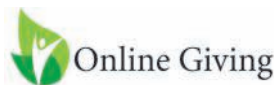
