2. What are the current or active plans and dreams you are currently working on or discussing?

- Current Initiatives:
 - Forming and Supporting Small Groups in our Parish
 - 72 official groups that have responded to survey of small groups
 - Volunteer Task Force
 - Jodi on Task Force commissioned by Fr Paul with Gigi Bondi and June Bounds (with work from Sarah Mancini)
 - Beginning recruitment for 2018-2019 using 6-month process from Ministry Architects – brainstorming numbers needed
 - Reregistration - Day of Quality process follow up – plan to make re-registration better for families for 2018-19 year – moving to online registration – have exciting plan in place for incentives for those who register by a certain deadline – trying to re-register 160 families + add new ones
 - Volunteer recruitment for Faith Formation Volunteers – at 14.5% of total spots filled, and 50% of brainstormed names have said yes or maybe so far
 - One Message – Easter Plans – in process, Pentecost Family Festival May 19
 - One Message – Fall 2018 – planning to gather a team to plan fall season – initiative 40 days of payer for healing
 - CYO Soccer – working to offer this in the fall for potentially 4 coed teams in grades 3-6 for 60-80 youth
 - CYO Basketball – monthly planning meetings to prep for next year
 - Baptismal Prep – met with Staff and priests to begin implementation of unified Saint Kateri Baptismal Prep Process
 - Young Adult Ministry Task Force – in gathering process for team members – will invite to summer alpha and pop up prayer
 - Summer Alpha for all ages – starts June 24
 - Pop Up Prayer Garden 6Pm on Fridays starts July 6
