

Finance Council – Notes

- For the 12 months ending June 30, 2018, offertory decreased 4% compared to last year, and is 13% below budget. Average Mass attendance (based on the month of October 2017) was 1606 versus 1773 in October 2016. The reduction of 167 represents 9%. Current registered families equals 3,536.
- Revenue from tuition at Saint Kateri School increased 11% versus prior year as a result of higher enrollment (203 students). Grants, contingent upon availability, were 13% lower than prior year.
- In March 2018, the parish received a generous anonymous donation in the amount of \$200,000 designated to offset operating expenses in the current fiscal year.
- Personnel Costs and Contracted Services represent 77% of the parish expense.




Finance Council Notes

- Non-operating Revenue includes net proceeds from sale of the former Saint Salome Church plus increases in market value of investments. Scholarship Disbursements from the Education Fund are reflected in Non-operating Expense. Capital improvement spending is significantly lower than previous years. The parish exceeded the \$220,508 goal for the Catholic Ministry Appeal by \$1,092.
- The parish remains free of debt, managing cash flow prudently to cover the cost of daily operations with revenue from collections, tuition, donations, and grants.




Parish Regular Collections






Comparative Charts -Revenue




JUNE 30, 2018 YTD ACTUAL OPERATING REVENUE \$3,012,425






Comparative Charts - Expenses

JUNE 30, 2018 YTD ACTUAL OPERATING EXPENSES \$3,178,427






Catholic Ministries Appeal (CMA)
