Food donations: Drop off in baskets at Church

Nov. 9/10: Soup, canned fruits and vegetables, dessert mixes.

Nov. 16/17: Stuffing, gravy mixes, cranberry sauce, crackers, peanut butter, jelly

Nov. 23/24: Mac & cheese, pasta, sauces, rice, jello

Nov. 29/Dec 1: Tuna, coffee, tea, hot chocolate, cereal, cookies

Dec.7/8: Personal care items (toiletries), toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, dish and laundry detergent. This is the last call for any of the items listed above.
