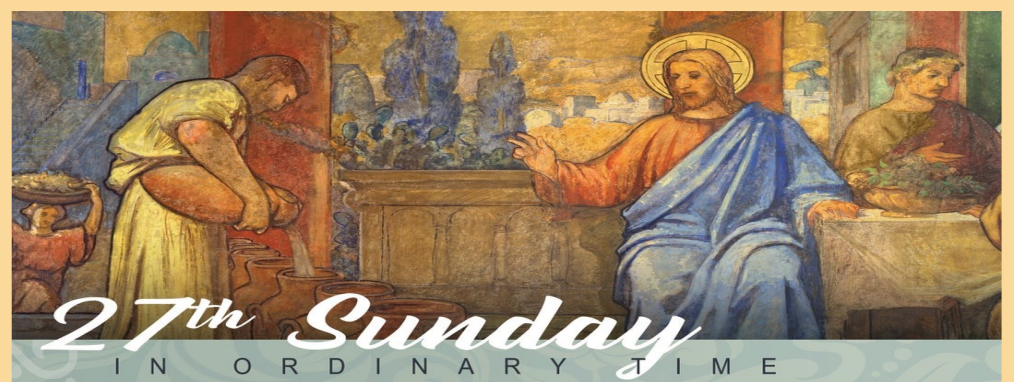

Take as your norm the sound words that you heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. Guard this rich trust with the help of the Holy Spirit that dwells within us." 2 Timothy 1

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The month of October begins! The end of September and the start of October is one of my favorite times because we can celebrate many special Saint days. But we can't forget the angels! On September 29th, we had the Feast of the Archangels, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. Then on October 2nd, the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels.

The Church has always recognized the presence of angels. Throughout the Bible, there are regular references to angels who communicate messages from God, rescue and protect people from danger. In the book of Genesis, Chapter 3, angels stood at the gate of the Garden. In the book of Genesis, chapter 32, Jacob wrestled with an angel. In the Gospel of Luke, 1:26, the Blessed Mother received a visit from the Angel Gabriel that she was to become the Mother of God. After Jesus' birth in Bethlehem, Joseph was instructed by an angel to take Mary and Jesus and flee from evil King Herod into Egypt. Before his Passion, Jesus was comforted by angels in the Garden of Olives in Luke 22:41-43: "He withdrew about a stone's throw beyond them, knelt down and prayed, 'Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.'" An angel from heaven appeared to him and strengthened him." In the Acts of the Apostles, 12:7, St. Paul was set free by an angel from his prison chains and led out to safety.

In the year 1608, Pius V added the Feast of the Guardian Angels to the church calendar of Saints. Parents for centuries, and still today, ask God to protect their children from danger, under the watchful care of their guardian angel. While angels do not have human bodies as we do, our own Guardian Angel accompanies us throughout our lives. Imagine the day when we must leave this earth to stand in the presence of God and our Guardian Angel, who has been with us from the first moments of life! Imagine the stories that will be told!

Here is a prayer I learned from my second-grade teacher...

Angel of God, my guardian dear to whom God's love entrusts me here, ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.

- Before a difficult personal or professional encounter, call upon your guardian angel and the other's guardian angel to help you communicate more clearly with one another.
- Pray the traditional guardian angel prayer or other prayers to guardian angels. When we remember to call upon them, the angels will help us harvest spiritual fruit.

On this weekend, the people of St. Kateri Parish in Irondequoit extend our welcome to His Excellency Most Rev. Steven J. Lopes, STD

Pope Francis named him the Bishop of the Ordinariate of the Chair of Saint Peter on Nov. 24, 2015. He is the shepherd of St. Alban's Community who worships at St. Cecilia's Church. Founded in 2012, the Ordinariate is a non-territorial diocese with the particular mission of unity among Christians. The Ordinariate parishes have come into full communion with the Catholic Church from the Episcopal/Anglican tradition, and continue to bring that rich patrimony of English Catholicism to new fruitfulness.

Bishop Lopes was born in Fremont, Calif. to Barbara Jane and (the late) Dr. José de Oliveira Lopes. The only child to two educators – his father taught languages and history at the university level, and his mother taught in Catholic schools for 47 years — Bishop Lopes was formed and educated by Catholic schools in the Golden State: St. Pius School (Redwood City, Calif.); St. Edward School (Newark, Calif.); and Moreau Catholic High School (Hayward, Calif.).

After undergraduate studies at the University of San Francisco, he entered St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park, Calif. He completed his seminary education at the Pontifical North American College in Rome. On June 23, 2001, he was ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of San Francisco by Cardinal William J. Levada (then Archbishop Levada).

As a priest of the Archdiocese, he served in two of its parishes: St. Patrick Catholic Church in San Francisco and St. Anselm Catholic Church in Ross, Calif.

He studied philosophy and liturgy at the University of Innsbruck. He earned licentiate and doctorate degrees in sacred theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, where he also served as an adjunct faculty member from 2005-2015.

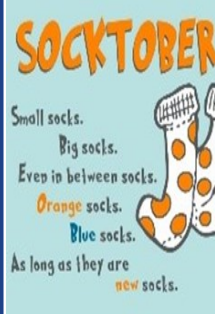
